

15. refers to a (usually abnormal) rhythm of the heart on auscultation, like a gallop

- 1. indicator of a possible heart attack, but it may also be a symptom of another condition or problem
- 2. Blowing or swishing sound due to a turbulent blood flow
- 6. regular or irregular

- 7. shortness of breath (dyspnea) that occurs when lying flat, causing the person to have to sleep propped up in bed or sitting in a chair.
- **12.** vibrations detected on palpation
- **13.** strong outward thrust of the chest wall during systole, results from an enlarged ventricle
