

8. When patient has been wheezing and then absent of wheezing sound and struggling to breath

9. combination of clinical manifestations along with reversible expiratory airflow limitations.

10. Usually occurring within 30 - 60 minutes after exposure to an allergen

12. Measures by peak flow meter is an aid to help diagnosis asthma
