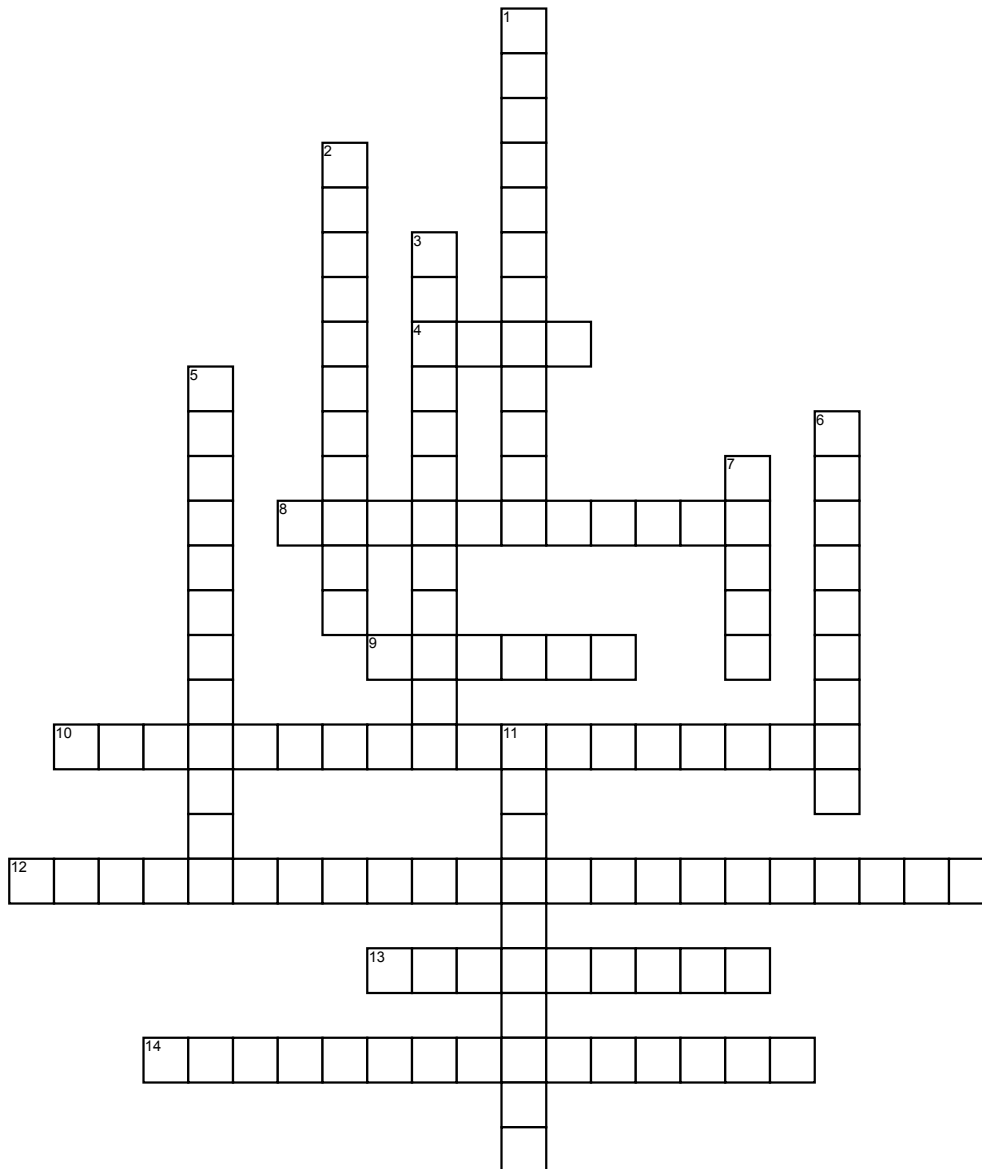

- 4. Disease more common in people with asthma
- 8. When patient has been wheezing and then absent of wheezing sound and struggling to breath
- 9. combination of clinical manifestations along with reversible expiratory airflow limitations.
- 10. Usually occurring within 30 - 60 minutes after exposure to an allergen

- 12. Measures by peak flow meter is an aid to help diagnosis asthma
- 13. When symptoms occur 4 - 6 hours after early response
- 14. Induced or exasperated by physical activity

- 1. Type of asthma when a cough is the only symptom
- 2. Nasal polyps, asthma, and sensitivity to aspirin and NSAIDs

- 3. Proliferation of a new blood vessel
- 5. Ask patients to report signs of toxicity with this drug
- 6. Small machine used to to convert drug solutions into mist
- 7. Genetic disposition to an allergy
- 11. Chronic inflammation may result in structural changes in the bronchial wall.
