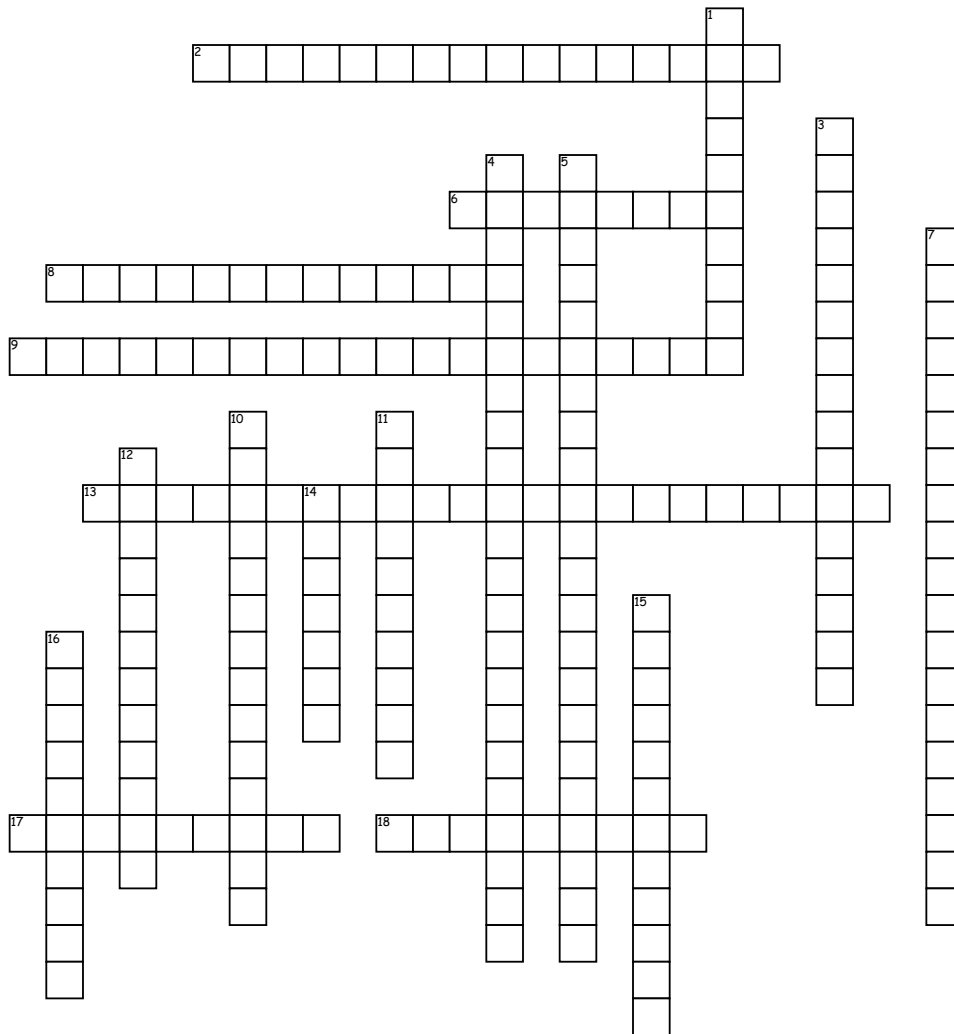

- 2. The world's largest coral reef system composed of over 2,900 individual reefs and 900 islands stretching for over 2,300 kilometers.
- 6. A marginal sea of the South Pacific off the northeast coast of Australia, and classified as an interim Australian bioregion.
- 8. Tariff, quota, and embargo.
- 9. A process which provides private individuals an opportunity to influence public decisions and has long been a component of the democratic decision-making process.
- 13. The spread of people across the world, i.e. where do people live.
- 17. A system of government by the whole population or all the eligible members of a state, typically through elected representatives.

18. A large sandstone rock formation in the southern part of the Northern Territory in central Australia. Also known as "Uluru".

- 1. A group of states with a central government but independence in internal affairs.
- 3. Materials or substances such as minerals, forests, water, and fertile land that occur in nature and can be used for economic gain.
- 4. A form of monarchy in which the sovereign exercises authority in accordance with a written or unwritten constitution.
- 5. A form of government in which the party (or a coalition of parties) with the greatest representation in the parliament (legislature) forms the government, its leader becoming prime minister or chancellor.

- 10. A term used to describe the foundation of the present economic system.
- 11. A native person to Australia.
- 12. The action or process of settling among and establishing control over the indigenous people of an area.
- 14. Taxes on imported goods.
- 15. An economy that presents elements of 2 or more different economies
- 16. Originating or occurring naturally in a particular place; native.
