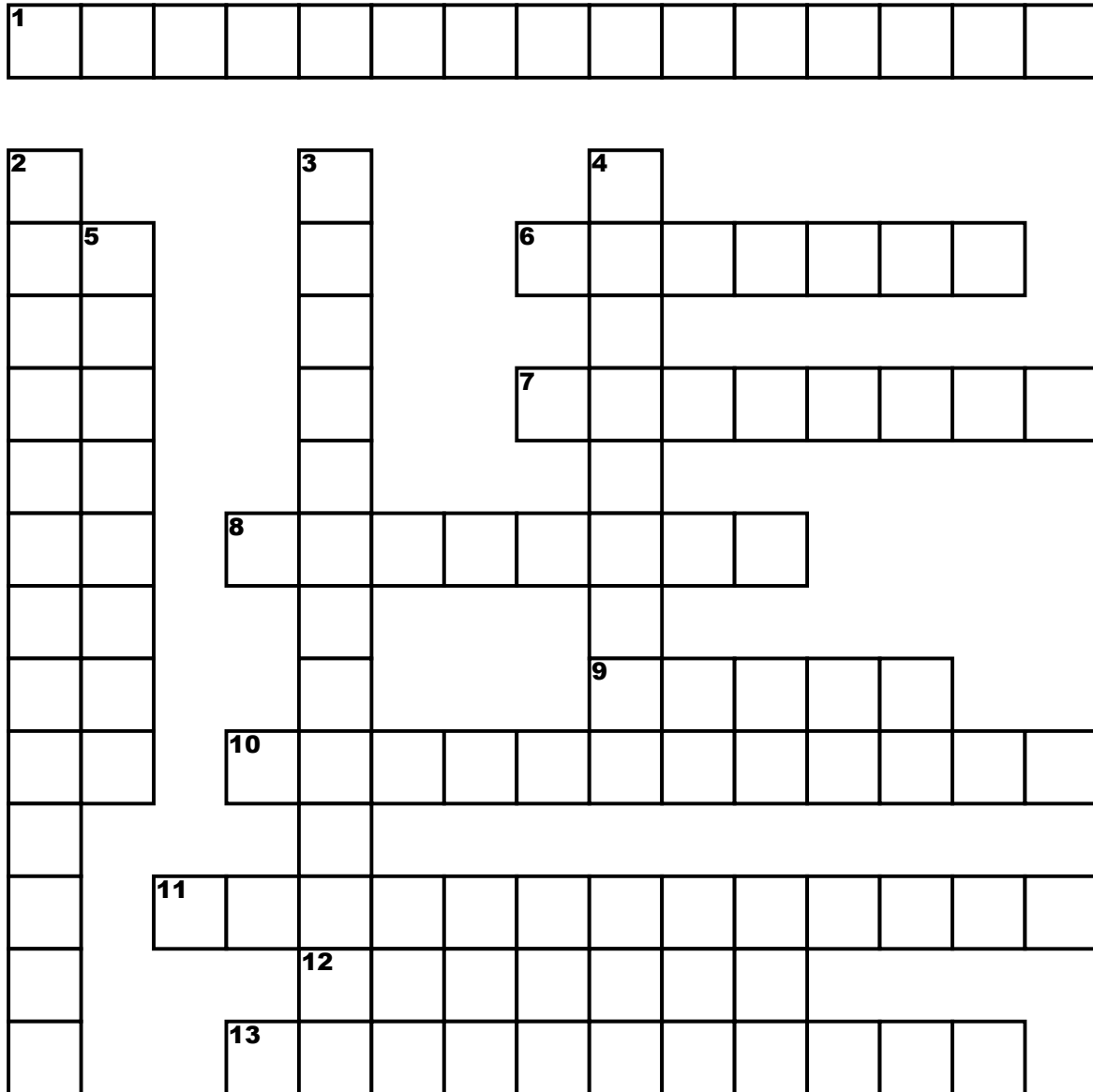


BAV Crossword Puzzle
