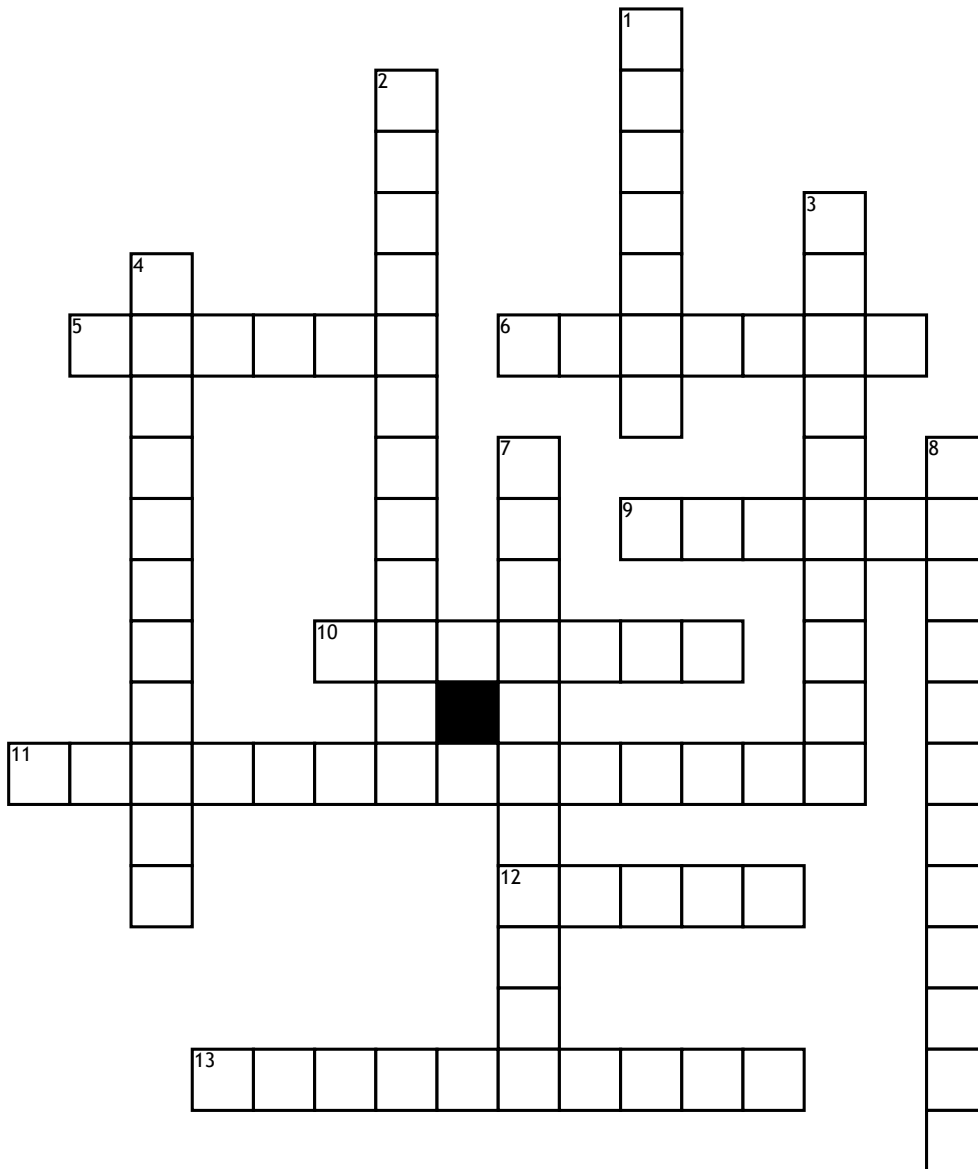

5. A credential awarded by a university or university-college after completion of a certain program of study; traditionally 4 years of study and 120 credits
 6. A group of courses leading to a specific credential
 9. One of the building blocks that makes up a program
 10. A formal credential awarded after a certain program of study; usually requires 2 years of study

11. Credit received for courses taken at another college or university
 12. A skilled job, typically one requiring manual skills and special training
 13. A person who works for another in order to learn a trade

 1. The charge of instruction at colleges and universities
 2. Requirement that must be met before a student may register in a course or program

3. An early entry opportunity for high school students to complete university-level courses while still in high-school
 4. A credential awarded after completion of a certain program; usually requires up to one year of study
 7. A form to be filled out at request being invited to study at a particular school
 8. The process of choosing and signing up for certain courses
