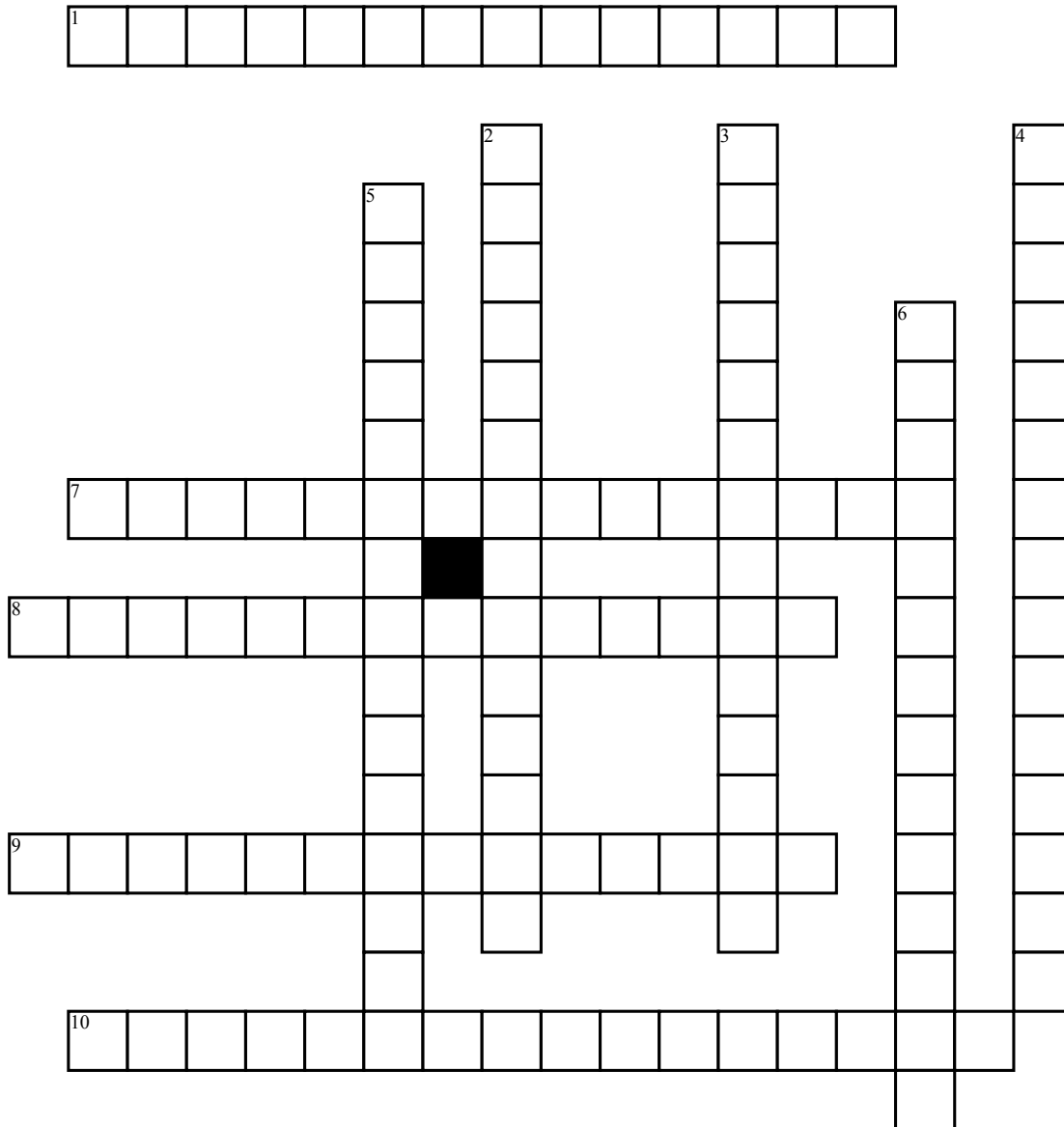

# BILL OF RIGHTS



## Across

1. The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.
7. The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue,
8. The enumeration in the Constitution of certain rights shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people
9. Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech,
10. In Suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed twenty dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be preserved, and no fact tried by a jury shall be otherwise reexamined in any Court of the United States

## Down

2. No Soldier shall, in time of peace be quartered in any house, without the consent of the Owner
3. No person shall be held to answer for a capital, or otherwise infamous crime, unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury
4. A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.
5. Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.
6. In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public
