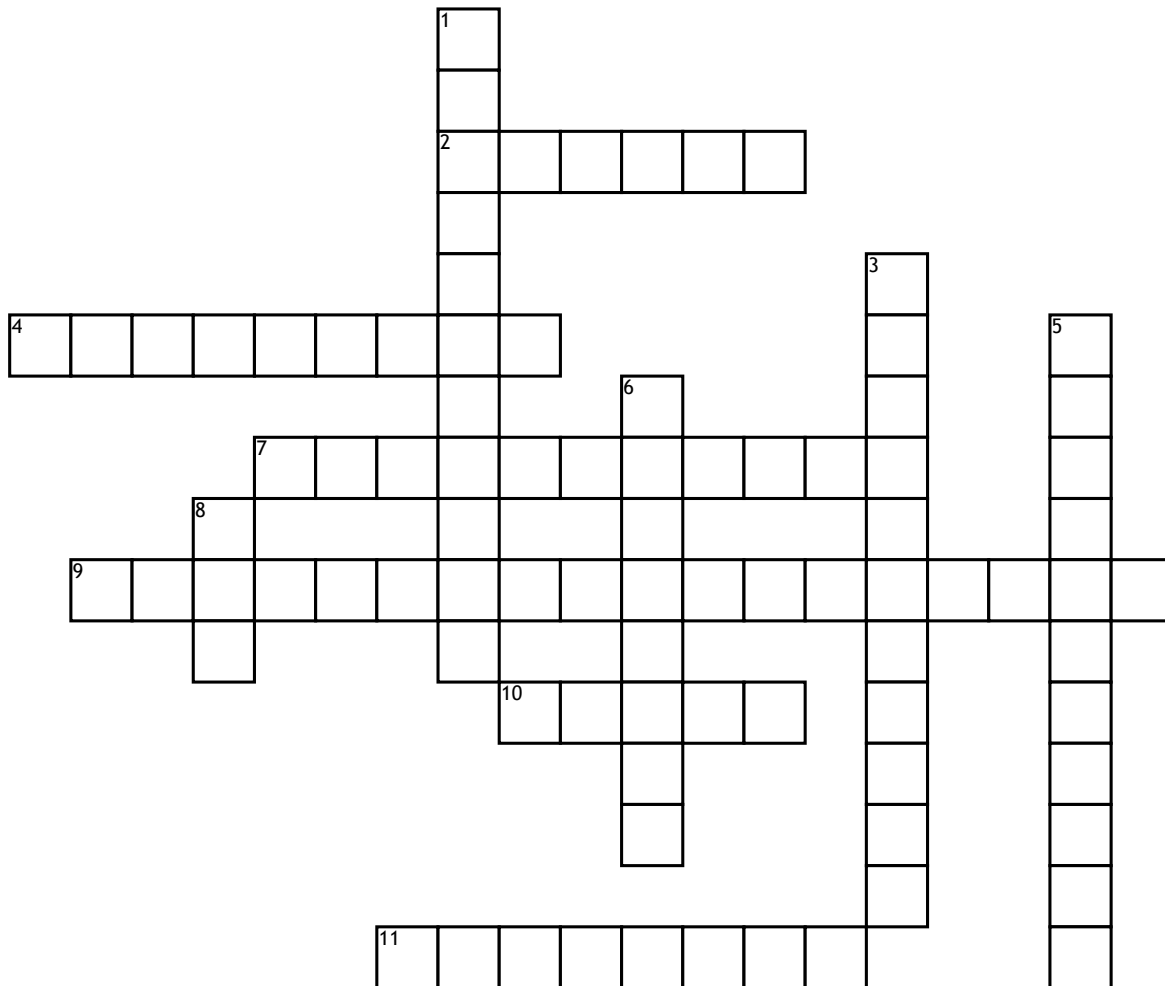

- 1. Group of individuals or volunteers to form a body (or organization) to accomplish a purpose. Examples Homeowners associations, churches.

- 5. Accounts opened for municipal, county, city or state. Examples Cities, Schools or Government Agencies.
- 6. Legal document created to support the formation of a business and identifies officers or managers.
- 8. An entity that combines the characteristics of a corporation, partnership or sole proprietorship and protects the owner's assets and liabilities.
