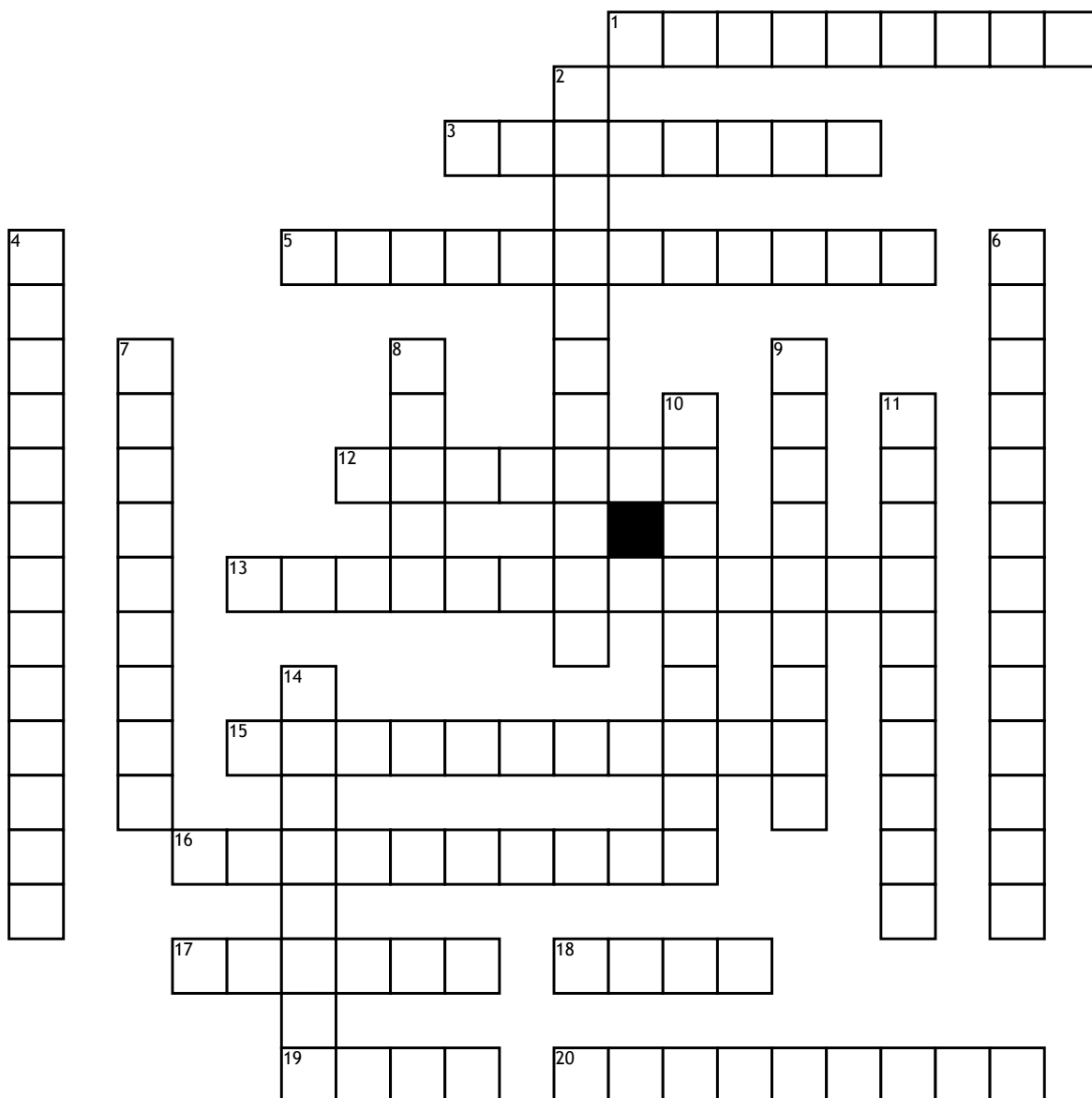

3. A method of baptism where water is poured on the head of the person being baptized. The word "affusion" comes from the Latin affusio, meaning "to pour on"

13. Ecclesiastical. a person under instruction in the rudiments of Christianity, as in the early church; a neophyte
15. our inner attitude and readiness for a particular sacrament
