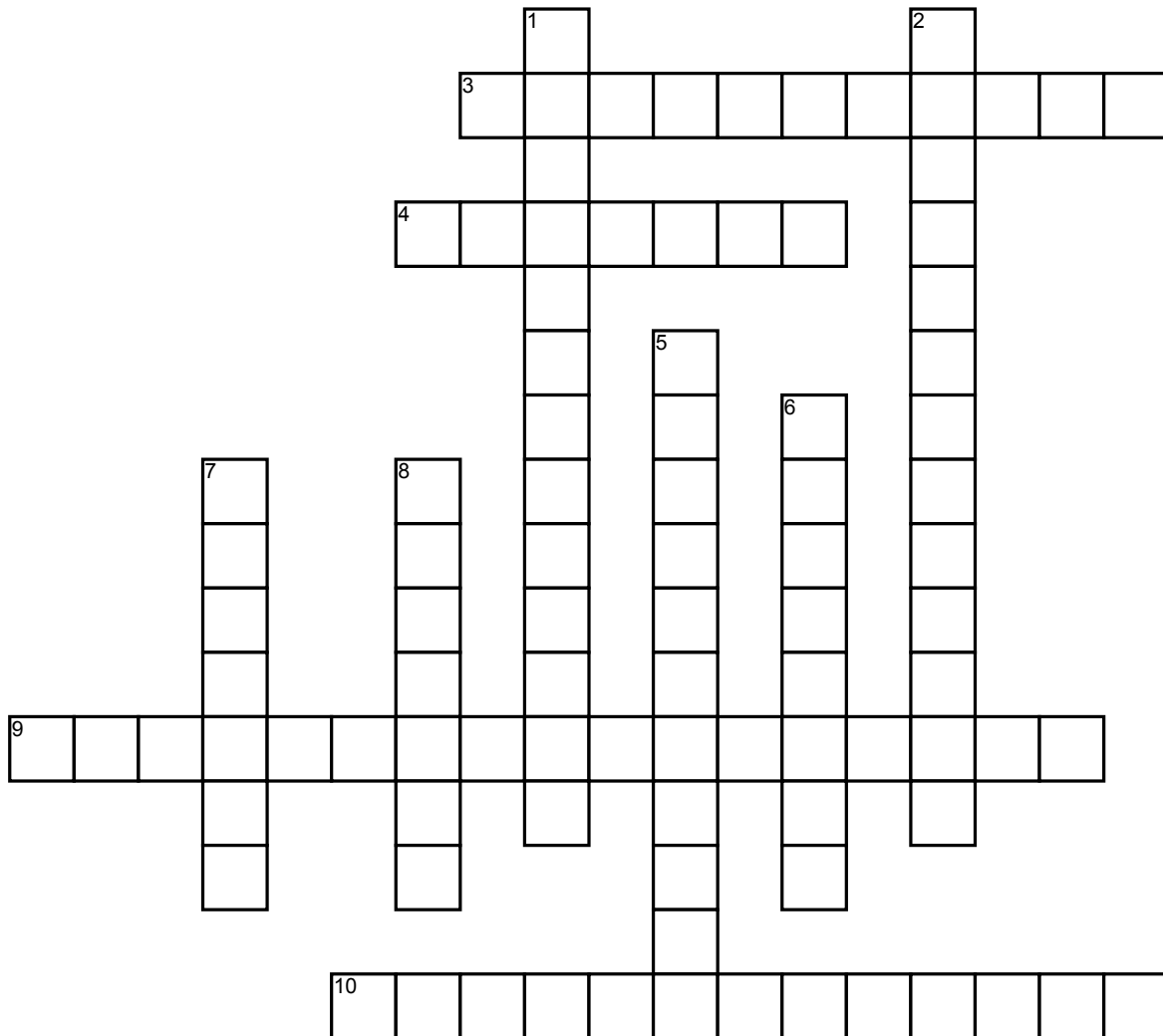


Behavioural and developmental issues of infants born to a substance-misusing mother

- 3.** Symptom of neonatal abstinence syndrome
- 4.** This substance is only present in the mother's urine for 24 hours after exposure
- 9.** A meeting will be held in the postnatal period to discuss the care of mother and baby
- 10.** This should be encouraged unless mothers are using cocaine

- 1.** Babies born to substance misusing mothers have a smaller head
- 2.** It is difficult to be certain of long-term affects on the neonate due to a combination of different factors
- 5.** Cocaine is known to cause abnormal brain
- 6.** This can be used to treat severe cases of NAS
- 7.** Most common type of drugs associated with neonatal abstinence syndrome
- 8.** Low self-esteem and low-social support in substance-misusing mothers may lead to poor mother-infant
