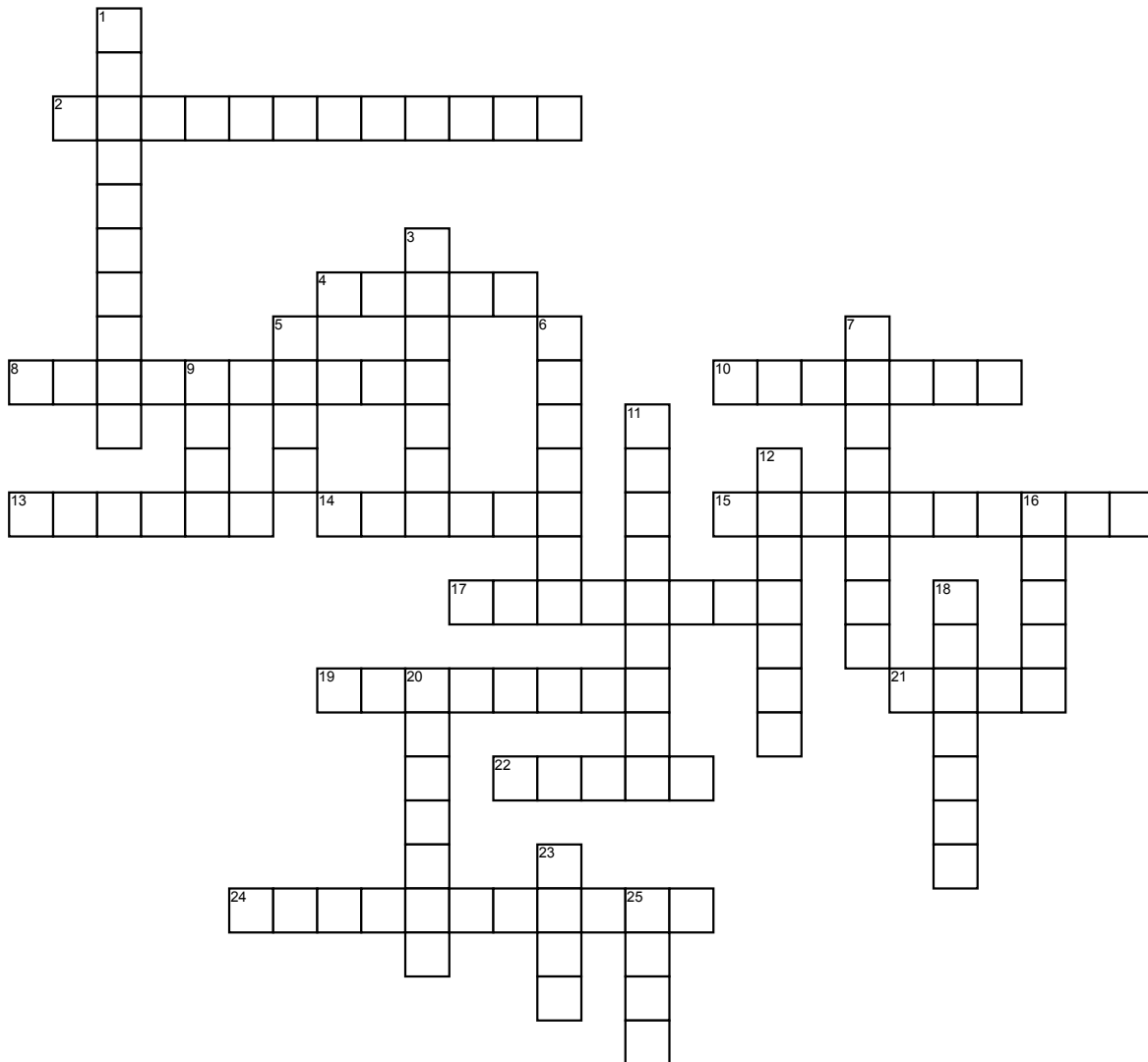


Beowulf's Crossword Puzzle
