

- 7. A series of trials and murders that began in the 1930's and lasted until 1953; the goal was to eliminate any opposition to the Communist Party in the Soviet Union.
- 8. An agreement between countries to maintain a peaceful alliance; one will not attack the other and vice versa
- 9. Leader of Japan after WWI; wanted to make Japan a major power like the US and Great Britain; sought to gain more land for resources to increase his industry
- A fascist dictator of Italy prior to and during WWII; took control of Rome by force

1. an economic downfall after WWI that impacted many countries world-wide; initiated by the Stock Market Crash in the USA; mass unemployment and world-wide poverty

- 2. the plan created to protect France from another German invasion by building large and small forts along the border; along with land mines and anti-tank trenches and steel walls
- 3. A communist dictator of Soviet Union (Russia) who took over after the death of Vladimir Lenin; very cruel & paranoid
- 4. Discrimination against Jews which was started by Adolf Hitler and the Nazi party with a list of laws from 1933 to 1939 and resulted in the Holocaust during WWII
- Nazi (fascist) dictator of Germany after WWI; wanted to unite Germany and get back land after Treaty of Versailles
- **6**. Money to be paid for war damages; Germany had to pay this to France and Belgium after WWI which created problems for the economy
