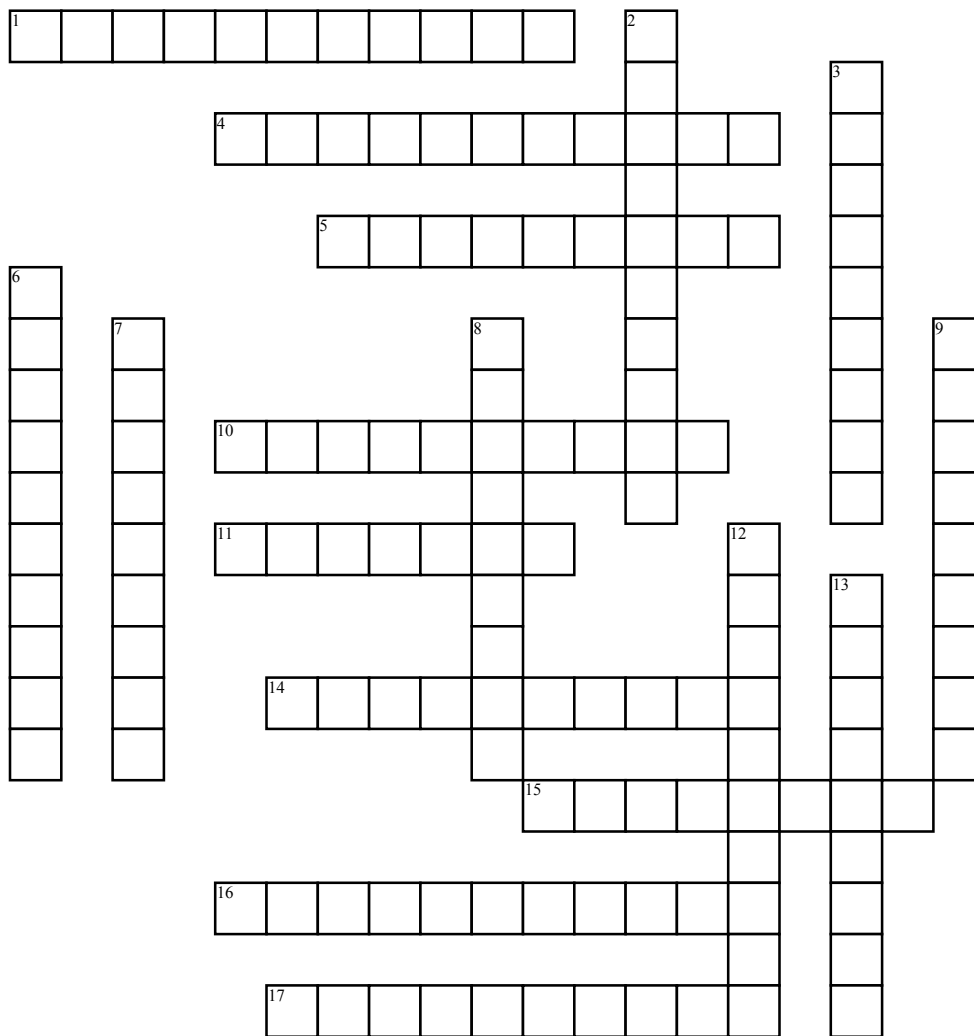

- 1. Residents of Washington D.C. right to vote
- 4. Senators are elected by the people of U.S.
- 5. Limited president to two terms
- 10. Prohibition of alcohol
- 11. Procedure of electing president and vice president (Electoral College)
- 14. Abolished poll taxes

- 15. Prohibits lawsuits among states in federal court (Immunity)
- 16. Delays Congressional pay increases until term following passage
- 17. Guaranteed U.S. citizenship & equal protection of all laws

- 2. Women Suffrage (right to vote)
- 3. Granted Congress the power to collect taxes

- 6. President succession procedures after death or removal
- 7. Prohibits restrictions on rights to vote based on race or color
- 8. Established terms and dates for president, vice president and Congress
- 9. Repeals Prohibition of alcohol
- 12. Abolished slavery
- 13. Sets voting age at 18 years old
