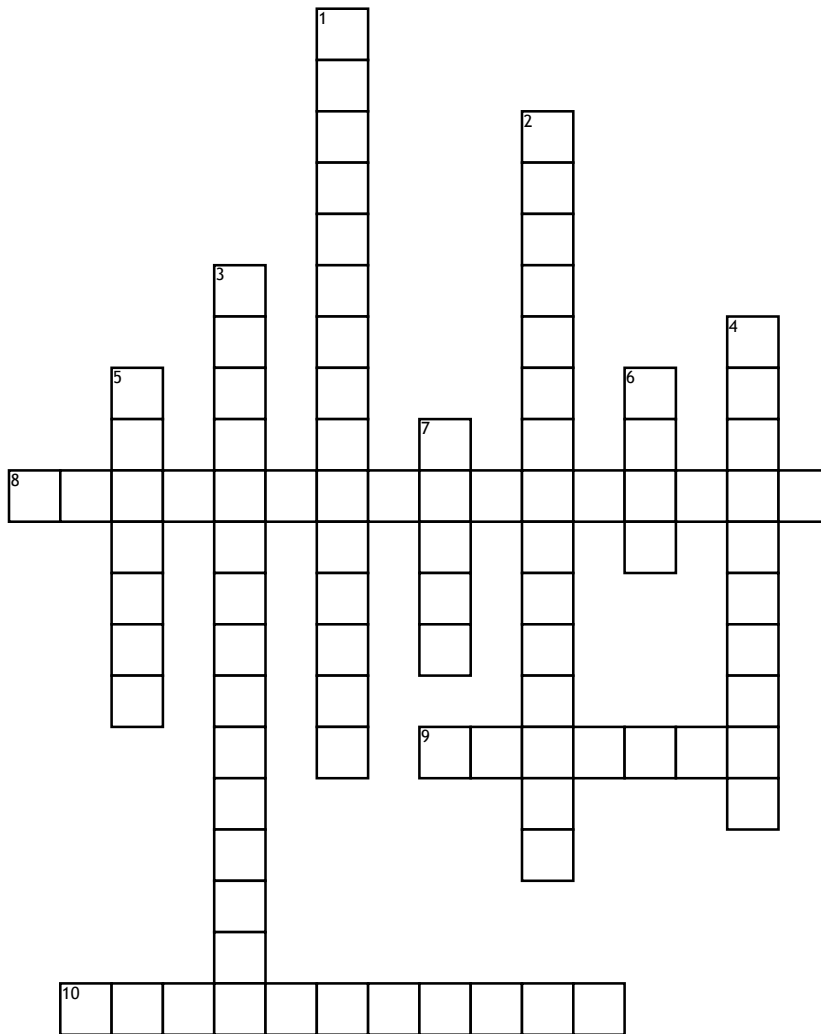

- 8. An opening in the earth's crust from which molten lava, rock fragments, ashes, dust, and gases are ejected from below the earth's surface.
- 9. Process of eroding or being eroded by wind, water, or other natural agents.
- 10. Formed through the cooling and solidification of magma or lava.

- 1. Rock that was once one form of rock but has changed to another under the influence of heat, pressure, or some other agent without passing through a liquid phase.

- 2. has formed through the deposition and solidification of sediment, especially sediment transported by water, ice, and wind.
- 3. When sedimentary, igneous, or other metamorphic rocks are subjected to heat and pressure from burial or contact with intrusive or extrusive igneous rocks.
- 4. Wear away or change the appearance or texture of (something) by long exposure to the air.
- 5. Make or become liquefied by heat
- 6. Hot molten or semifluid rock erupted from a volcano or fissure, or solid rock resulting from cooling of this
- 7. Hot fluid or semifluid material below or within the earth's crust from which lava and other igneous rock is formed by cooling.
