

**6**. Treeless arctic or alpine biome characterized by cold, harsh winters, a short growing season, and potential for frost any month of the year

**8**. a large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat

**9**. Evergreen trees that can stand the cold temperatures

10. Does not contain any saltwater and can be rivers, lakes, streams, ponds, and wetlands

**11**. An arid region with little or no precipitation

**12**. A group of organisms or populations living and interacting with one another in a particular environment

**13**. the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates.
