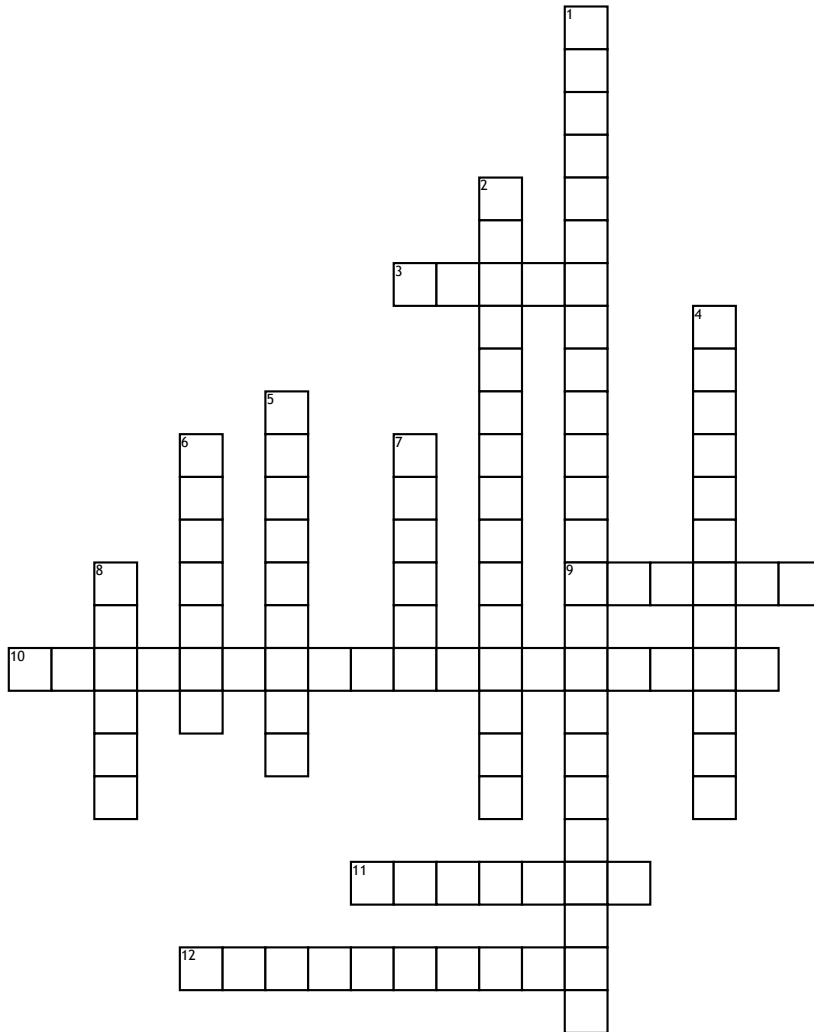


Biomes and Succession
