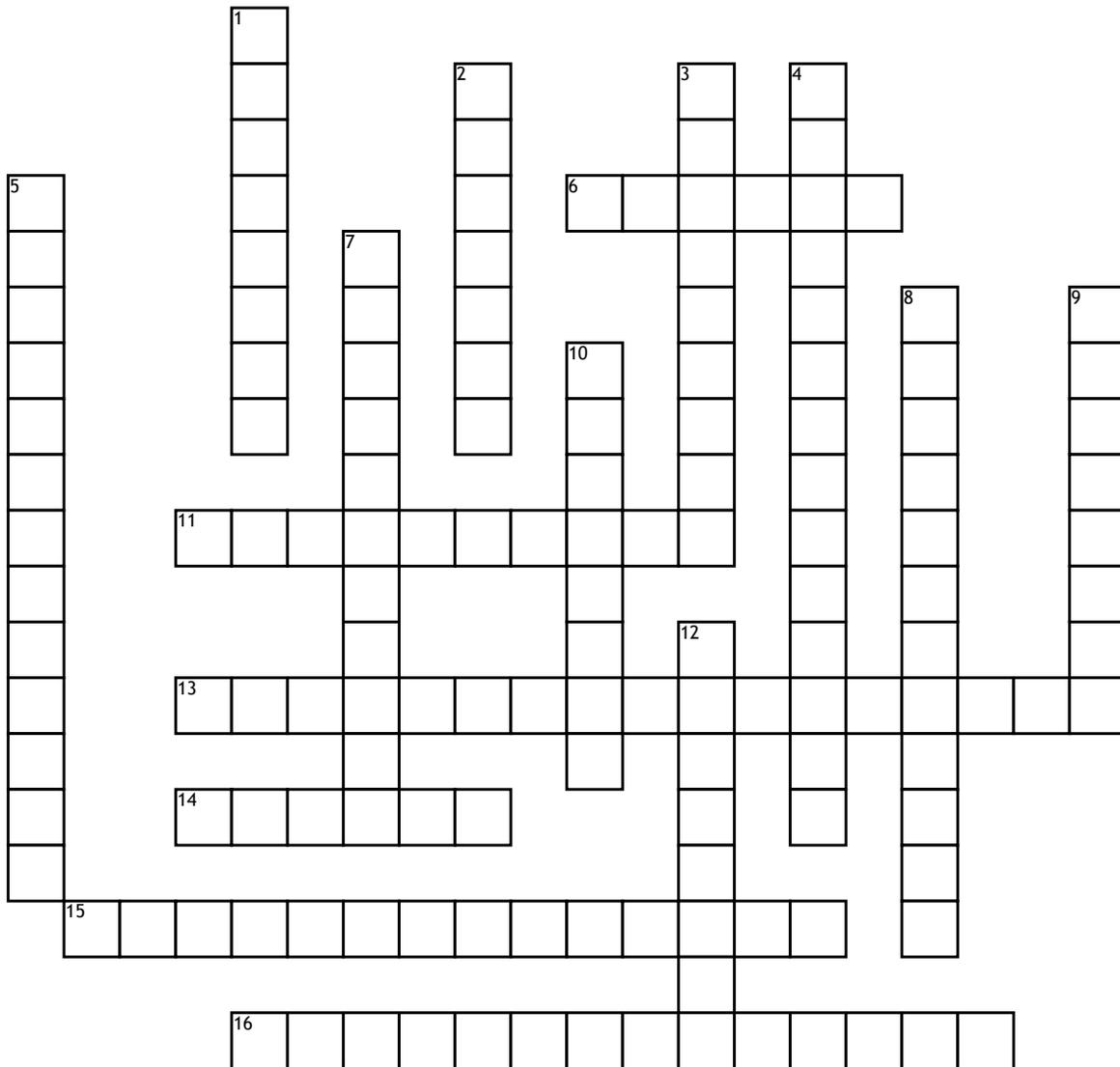

- 6.** A pathological state in which micro organisms, or their toxins are present in the bloodstream; syndrome of systemic inflammation in response to infection; a sub category of SziRS.
- 11.** White blood cells
- 13.** Accumulation of blood between the dura and arachnoid layers of the meninges.
- 14.** A lipolytic enzyme pancreatic its action contributes to necrosis of fatty tissue surrounding the pancreas in the presence of pancreatitis.
- 15.** The ability to determine spatial position; knowing where the body or body part is positioned in space.
- 16.** Stage where sufficient antibodies develop against a disease to be measurable against disease.

Down

- 1.** A protein found in cardiac muscle; when present in the blood, it is used as a marker of myocardial cell death.
- 2.** The net diffusion of water from area of greater concentration to area of lesser concentration across the cell membrane. Occurs as a result of osmotic pressure.
- 3.** Break down and splitting of fat.
- 4.** Loss of internal temperature control whereby the patient assumes the temperature of the environment.
- 5.** The volume of air that can be exhaled after maximum inhalation; an indication of respiratory muscle strength. Normal is 65 to 75 mL/kg.
- 7.** Heart rate greater than 100 bpm. (In our soldiers who are fit may be 80 - 100).

- 8.** Subjective feeling of heart rhythm abnormalities perceived by patient as skipping or thumping related to premature cardiac beats.
- 9.** Production of an abnormally small amount of urine. Less than 400ml in 24 hours. Or appropriate amount per kilo per hour.
- 10.** Chest pain that is not predictable, and that occurs with rest or minimal activity. SOMETHING.... Angina.
- 12.** Yellow pigment disease with sclera, skin and mucous membranes due to elevated bilirubin.
