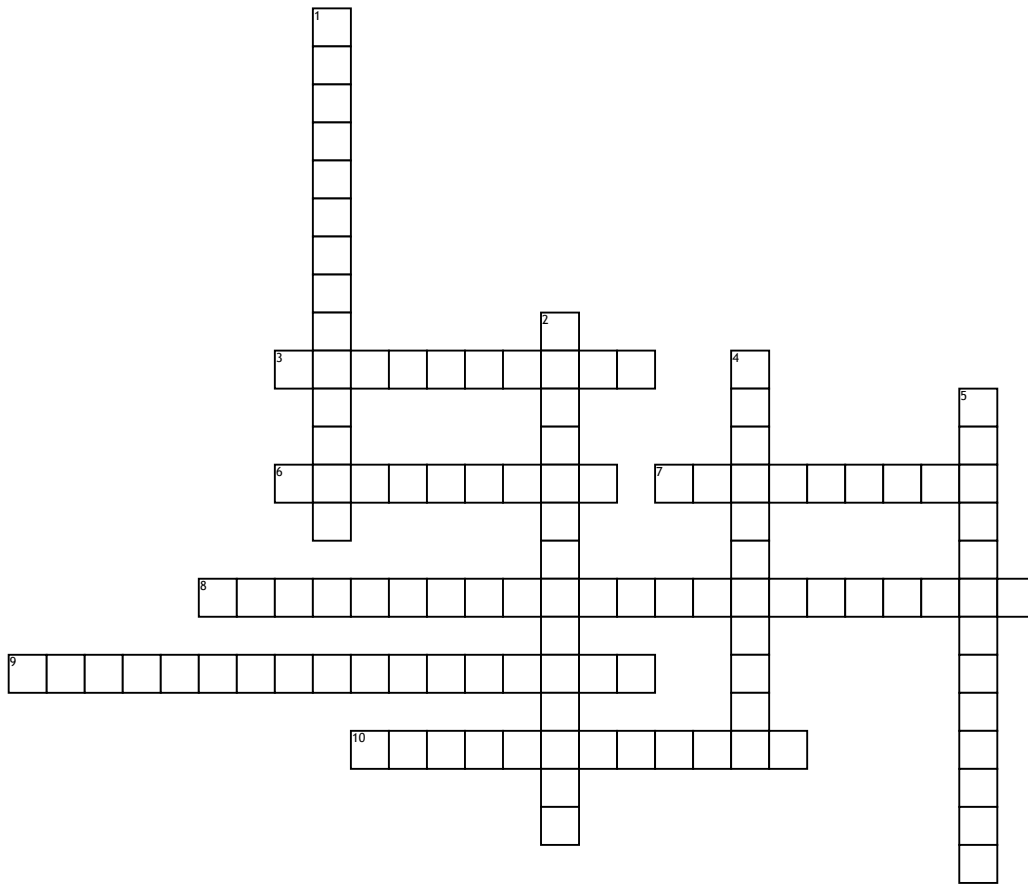


Black History Month Crossword
