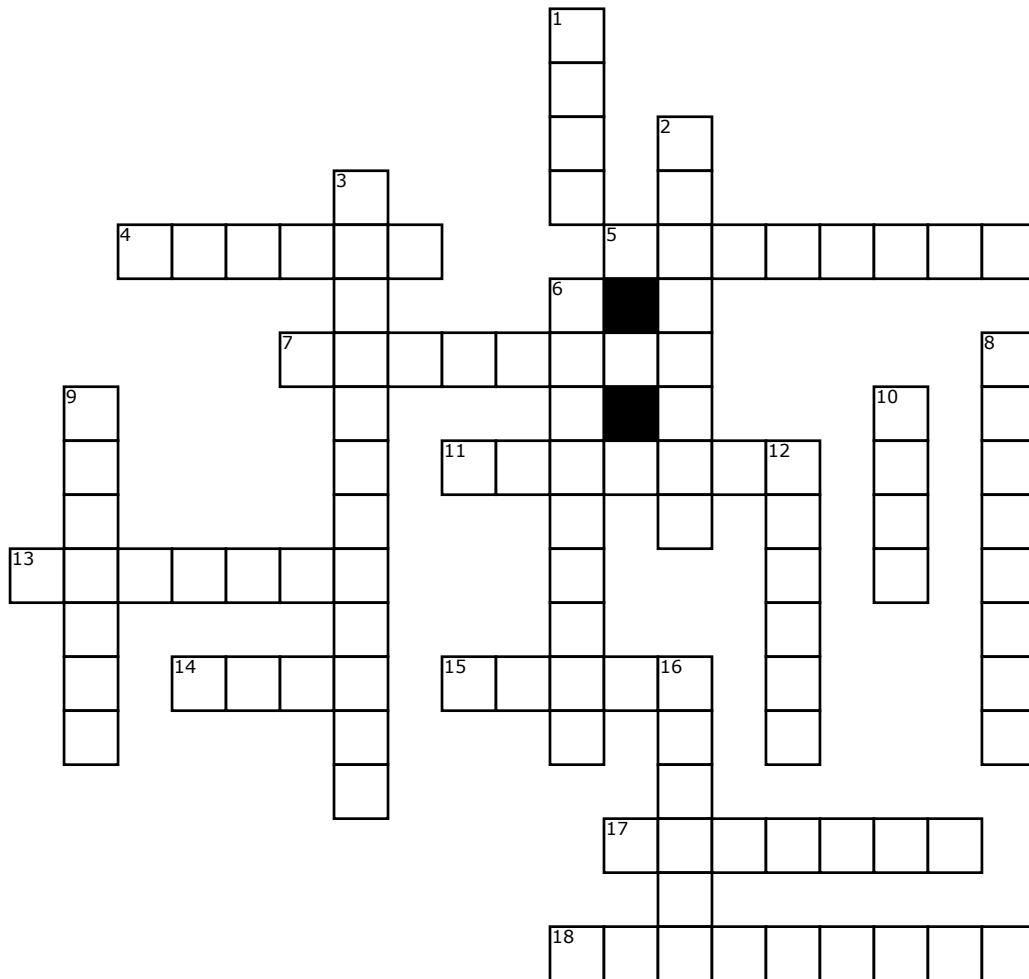


# Boudica Crossword
