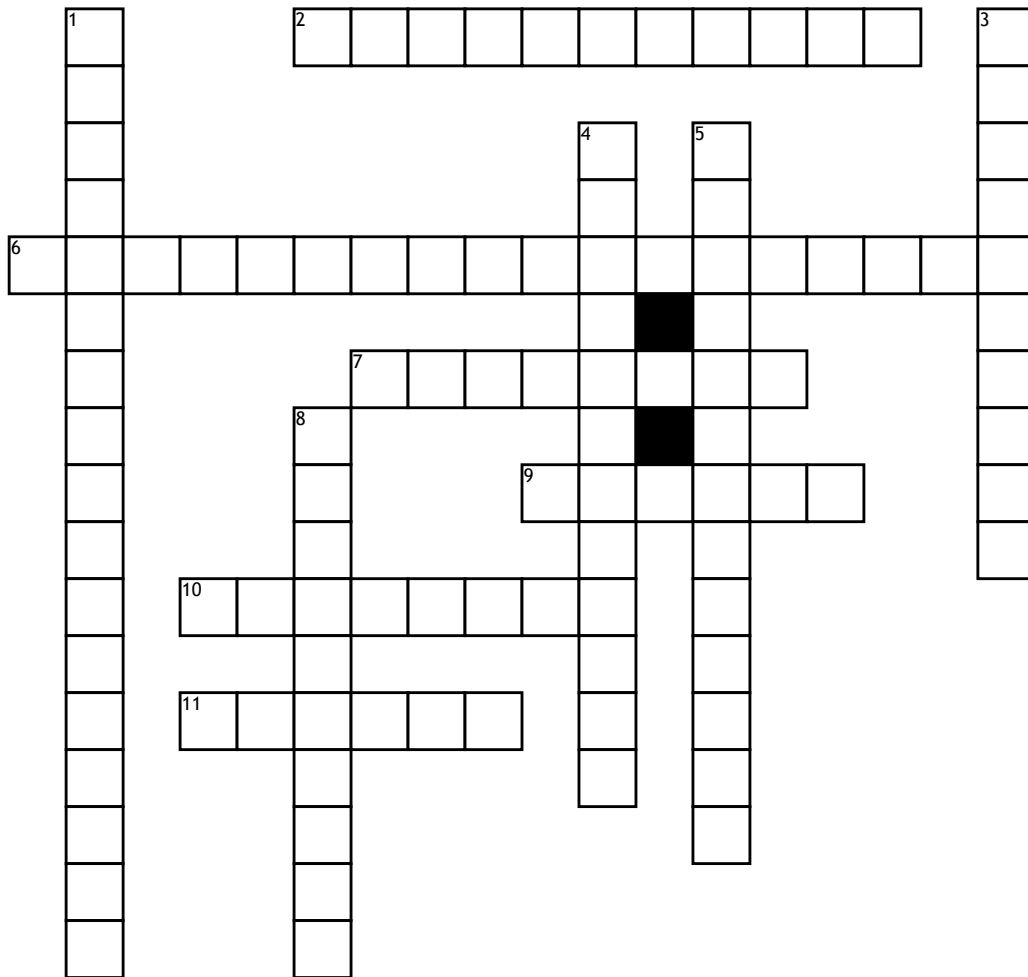


# Brexit Crossword
