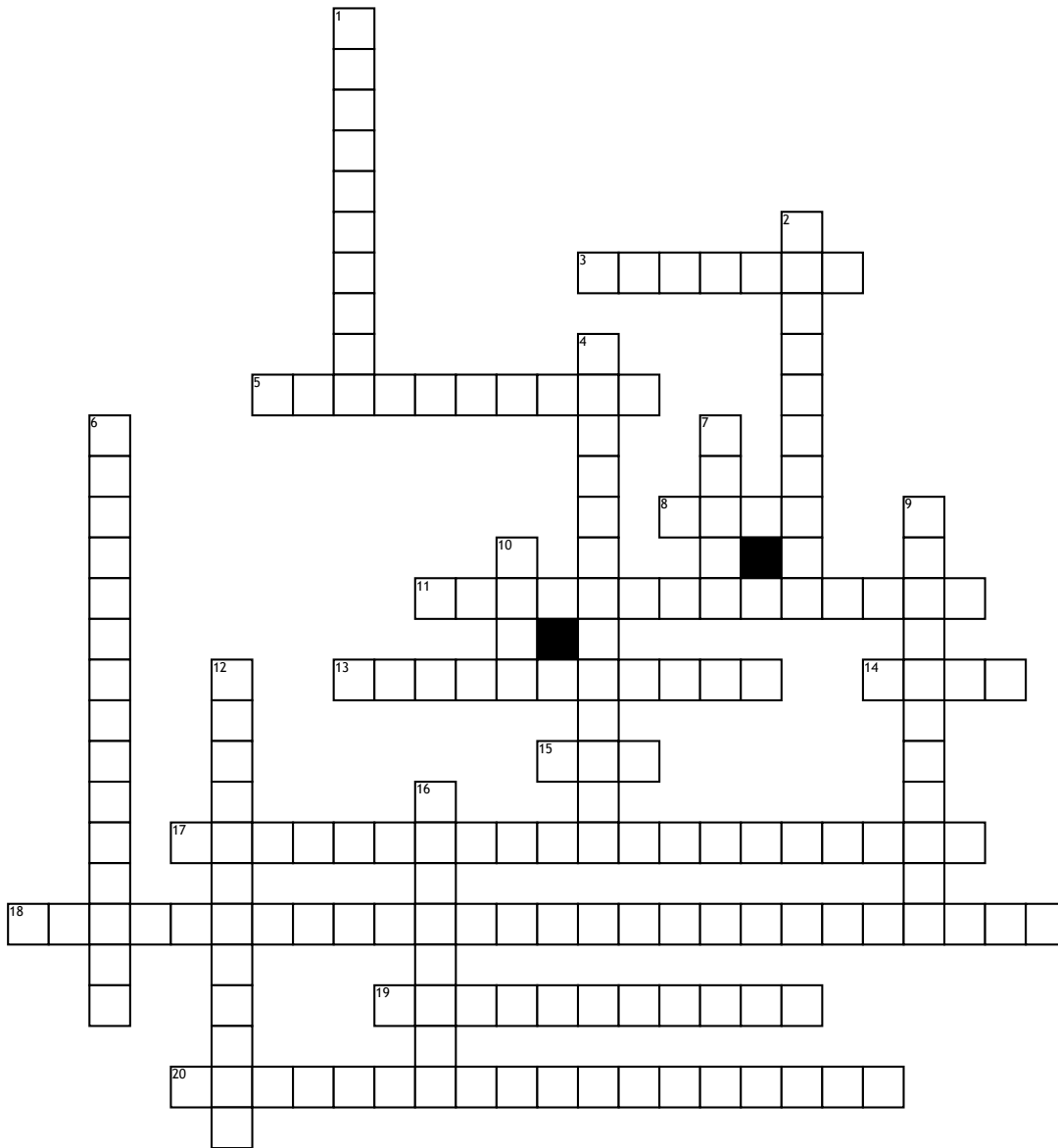

9. George F. Kennan's idea for American policy at the start of the cold war era, with the goal to keep communism contained within its existing borders

10. Committee created by the House of Representatives in 1938 to investigate possible subversive activities by fascists, Nazis, or communists; focus switched primarily to communism during the cold war
