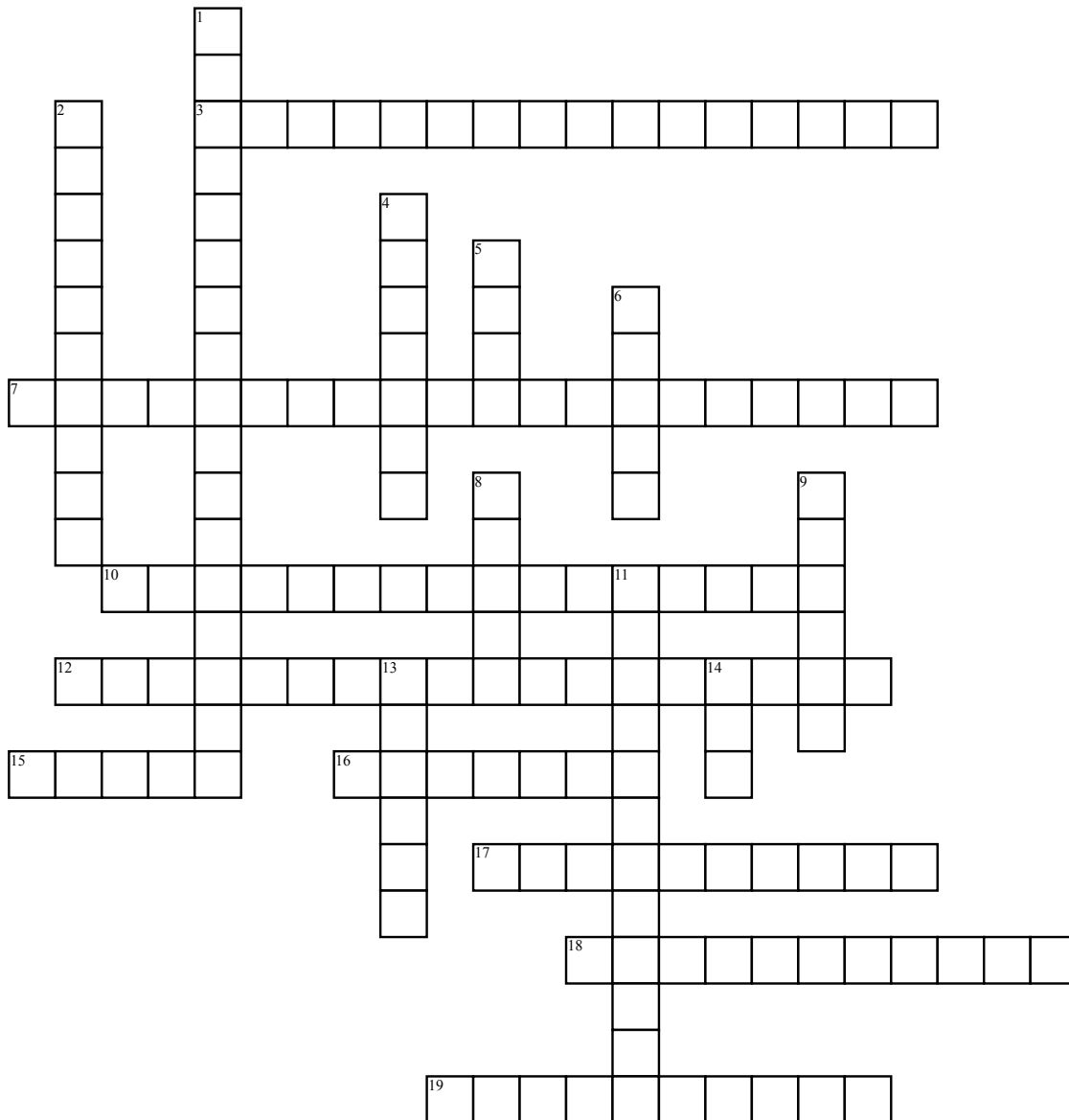

1. A resource which is replaced naturally and can be used again.
 2. Large natural or artificial lake used as a source of water supply
 4. Renewable source of energy which uses the force or energy of moving water to generate power
 5. a combustible black or dark brown rock consisting mainly of carbonized plant matter, found mainly in underground deposits and widely used as fuel
 6. a woody perennial plant, typically having a single stem or trunk
 8. a living organism of the kind exemplified by trees, shrubs, herbs, grasses, ferns, and mosses

9. A gaseous element constituting about one-fifth of the volume of the atmosphere and present in a combined state in nature. Also known as O₂.
 11. Electric or motive power generated by a nuclear reactor.
 13. Power derived from the utilization of physical or chemical resources, especially to provide light and heat or to work machines.
 14. A viscous liquid derived from petroleum, especially for use as a fuel or lubricant
