
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## **Buddhism Crossword Puzzle**

- **6.** The path to nirvana consisting of 8 aspects in which to be practiced
- **7.** Buddhist community of monks and nuns
- 8. Impermanence
- 9. Important Buddhist concept translated as "suffering", "pain", or "stress" in relation to life
- 12. Enlightened one
- 13. Cycle of death and rebirth to which life in the material world is bound
- **16.** Moral conduct; one of the three sections of the Eightfold Path
- 17. refers to an aspect of guidance along the Buddhist Paths to liberation where a conscious, voluntary action is driven by an incomplete reasoning about its direction

- **18.** Second of the Four Noble Truths, selfish desire, which causes dukkha (suffering)
- **19.** Person who has attained enlightenment but postpones nirvana in order to help others achieve enlightenment
- **20.** Sum of a person's actions in this and previous states of existence, viewed as deciding their fate in future existences
- **1.** Condition of great peace or happiness
- 2. The realities for dealing with the suffering humanity faces
- **3.** Compassion; part of the spiritual path of Buddhism
- 4. Development or production in the sense of calling into existence; spiritual cultivation

- **5.** Supernatural power wielded by gods and demons to produce illusions
- 10. Teaching or religion of the Buddha
- 11. Direct insight (wisdom) into the truth taught by Buddha, as a faculty required to attain enlightenment; one of the three divisions of the Eightfold Path
- **14.** Individual who has achieved individual enlightenment
- **15.** Idea that there is no permanent, underlying substance that can be called a soul
