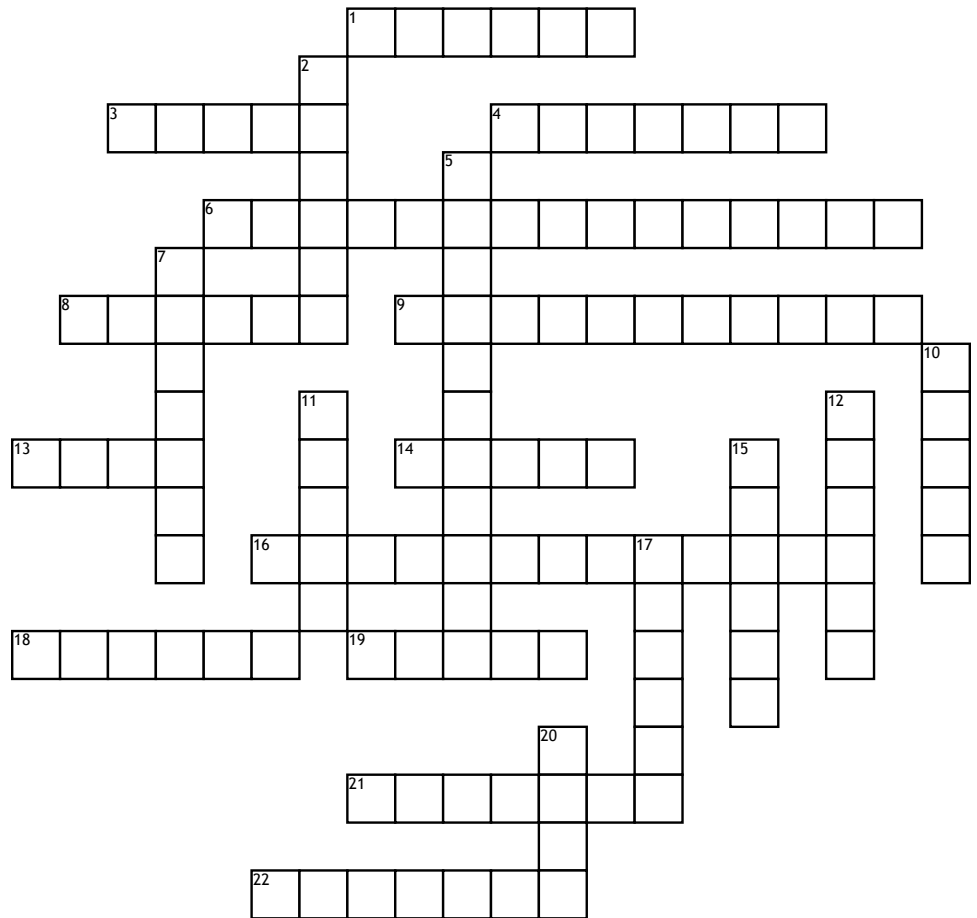


Buddhist Crossword Puzzle

- 1. Buddhist community, composed of both monks and nuns
- 3. Direct insight into the truth taught by Buddha, a faculty required to attain enlightenment
- 4. Spiritual cultivation, contemplation
- 6. Charts the the method for attaining the end of suffering
- 8. The doctrine that there is no permanent, underlying substance that can be called the soul
- 9. The central principles of life which guide and give refuge to Buddhists
- 13. Moral conduct, one of the 3 divisions of the Eightfold Path
- 14. Actions driven by intention which lead to future consequences

- 16. Buddhist path to liberation, broken up into 8 parts
- 18. The founder of Buddhism who sat underneath the Bodhi tree until he attained true enlightenment
- 19. An aspect of guidance along the Buddhist path where a conscious, voluntary action is driven by an "incomplete reason" about its direction
- 21. The cessation of desire and end of suffering, the final goal of Buddhism
- 22. The second of the Four Noble Truths, cause of desire

- 2. Compassion, a crucial quality necessary to achieve Enlightenment
- 5. A person who has attained enlightenment, but postpones Nirvana to aid others in their journey to Enlightenment
- 7. Cycle of death and rebirth
- 10. The second of the Four Noble Truths, "thirst"
- 11. Impermanence, part of the 3 marks of existence
- 12. An individual who has achieved Enlightenment
- 15. The teaching of the Buddha
- 17. Buddhist word for "suffering", the concept that sits at the heart of the Four Noble Truths
- 20. A supernatural power wielded by gods and demons, produces illusions
