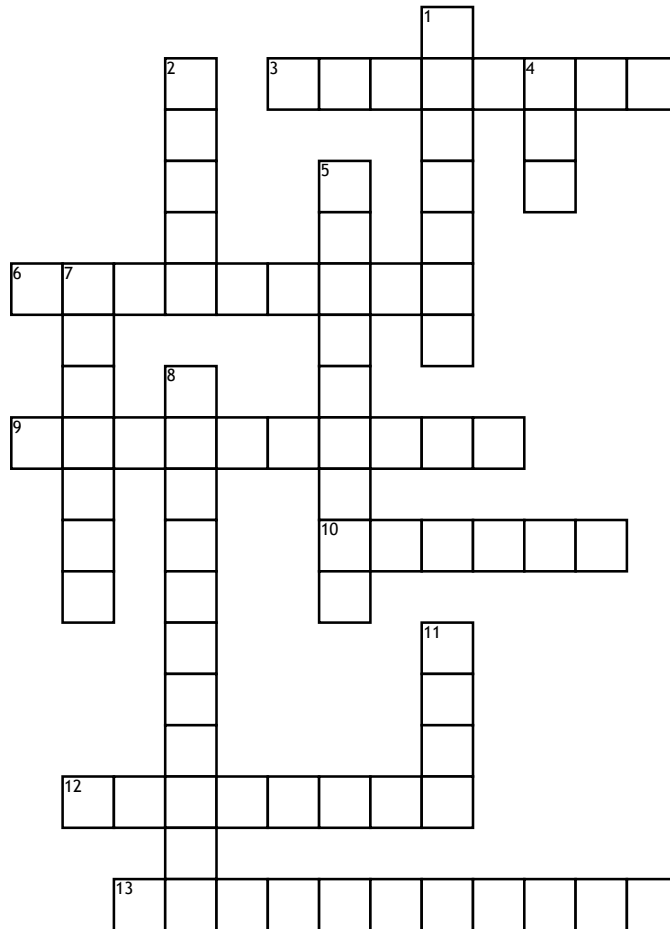

12. A binding agreement between parties that creates legally enforceable duties or obligations.

13. Litigation filed by the government (prosecution); burden of proof on the state (government).

1. Conflict between 2 or more parties.
2. Committed or omitted act in violation of law; case decision relies on definitions within law.
4. Rule of conduct enforced by controlling authority; provides order, stability, and justice.
5. A person who begins a lawsuit; complaining party.

7. Conducting yourself in accordance with the rules or standards for right conduct or practice.

8. Crime for which punishment is one year or less in jail and/or a fine.

11. A civil (private) wrong, not arising out of contractual obligations, that a court will give a remedy in the form of an action or damages; relies on case decisions and existing elements that must be present.
