

- **4.** blood in the stool with the appearance of black, tarry stool
- **6.** an excess of nitrogenous wastes (urea) in the blood
- 7. the accumulaton of nitrogenous wastes in the blood (azotemia); a result of renal failure, with clinical symptoms that include nausea and vomiting
- **9.** solution used in dialysis that contains a balanced mix of electrolytes and water and that closely resembles human plasma
- **10.** bone metabolism and structural damaage caused by chronic kidney disease- infused low calcium levels and high phosphorus levels

- 11. the systemic clinical and laboratory manifestations of end-stage kidney disease
- 1. layer of urea crystals from evaporated sweat may appear on the face, eyebrows, axillae, and groin in patients with advanced uremic syndrome
- 2. breathing pattern with respirations that are fast and deep; often associated with metabolic acidosis
- 3. disorders of the kidney or heart that cause dysfunction in the other organ
- 5. urine output less than 400mL/day
- **8.** abnormal increase in the depth of respiratory movements
