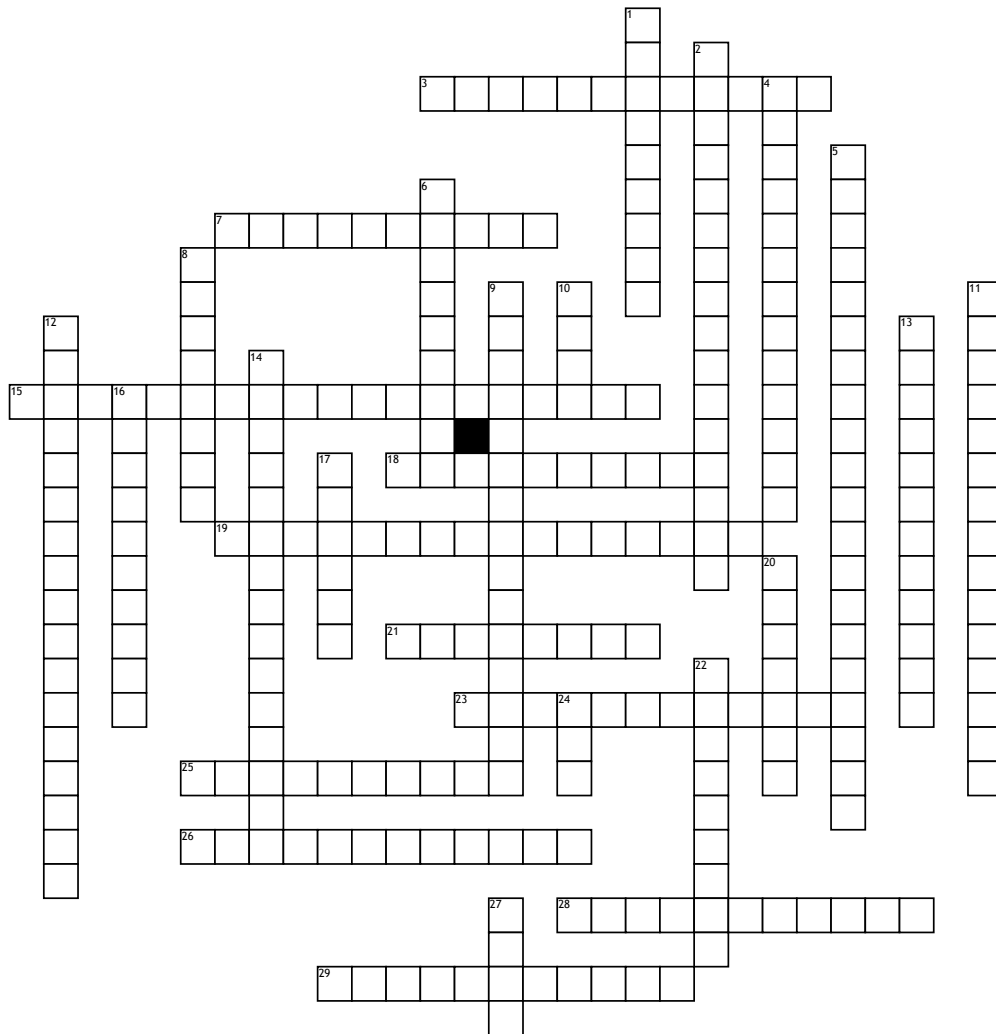

 15. Unpaid experiences; students work to get experience, contracts, or help out. The experiences are not necessarily career related and not usually supervised by school personnel

 19. the continuing development of knowledge and skills that people experience after formal education and throughout their lives

28. a vocational school, a trade school, or a high-level learning institution that specializes in providing students with the vocational education and technical skills they need in the order to perform the tasks of a particular job. Student typically earn a credential or a certificate

29. Money awarded to students based on academic or other achievements to help pay for education expense. Scholarships generally do not have to be repaid
