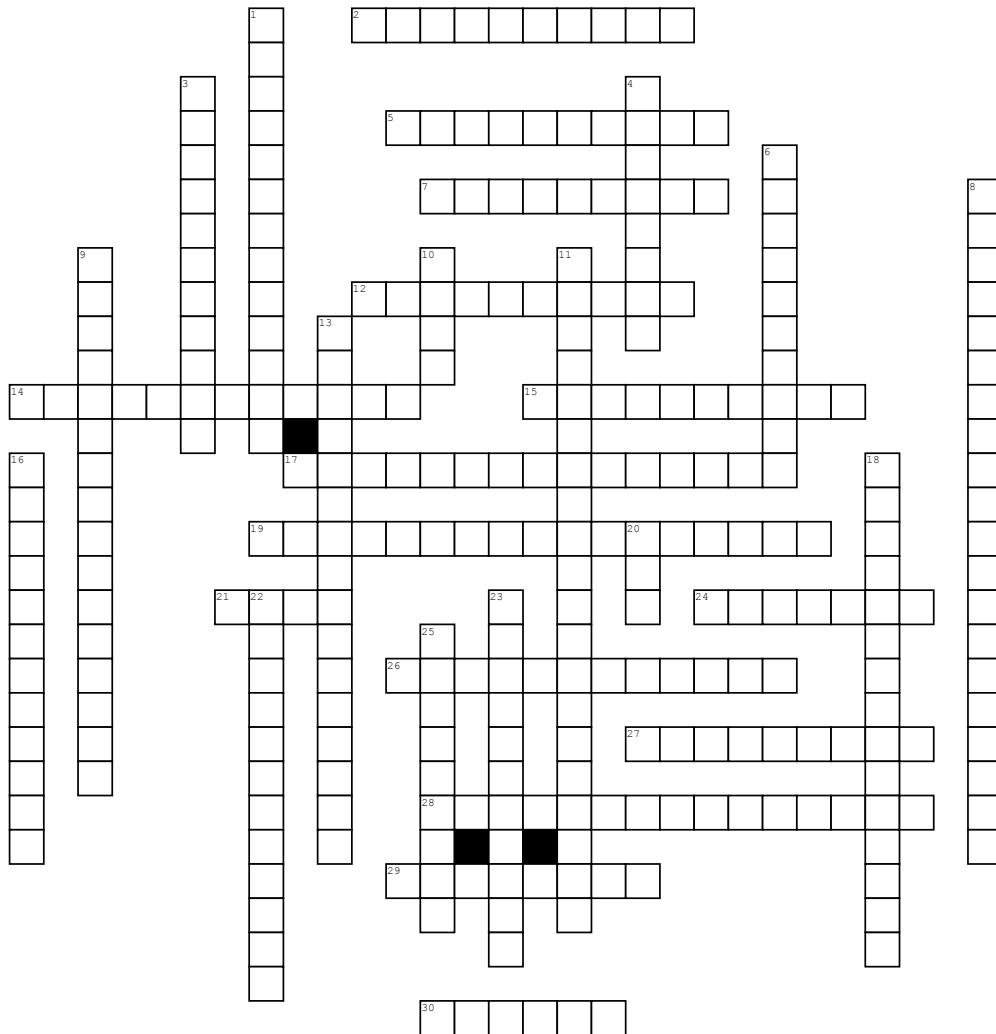

  - 3. money awarded to students based on academic or other achievement or other achievements to help pay for education expenses. scholarships generally do not have to be repaid

  - 6. stage in economic cycle, relatively low employment and production begin to rise to normal levels
  - 8. college program leading to an associate (2-year) or a bachelors (4-year) degree; generally following high/secondary school
  - 9. the continuing development of knowledge and skills that people experience after formal education and throughout their lives
