

- **3.** Increasing head of bed at this angle helps decreased chances of aspiration
- **5.** Done to help rid of secretions when patients aren't able to
- **9.** Used to decompress the stomach and prevent aspiration in intubated patients

- **11.** Used when patients are unable to breathe on their own
- **12.** Done to keep oral bacterial under control **Down**
- **1.** Placing patients on their side
- **2.** Must be done prior to providing patient care
- 4. Mask with an attached reservoir bag

- **6.** A noninvasive positive airway pressure device
- **7.** When a patient is placed chest down on the bed
- **8.** Technique used when providing endotracheal suctioning
- **10.** Has relatively "normal" compliance rather than low compliance
