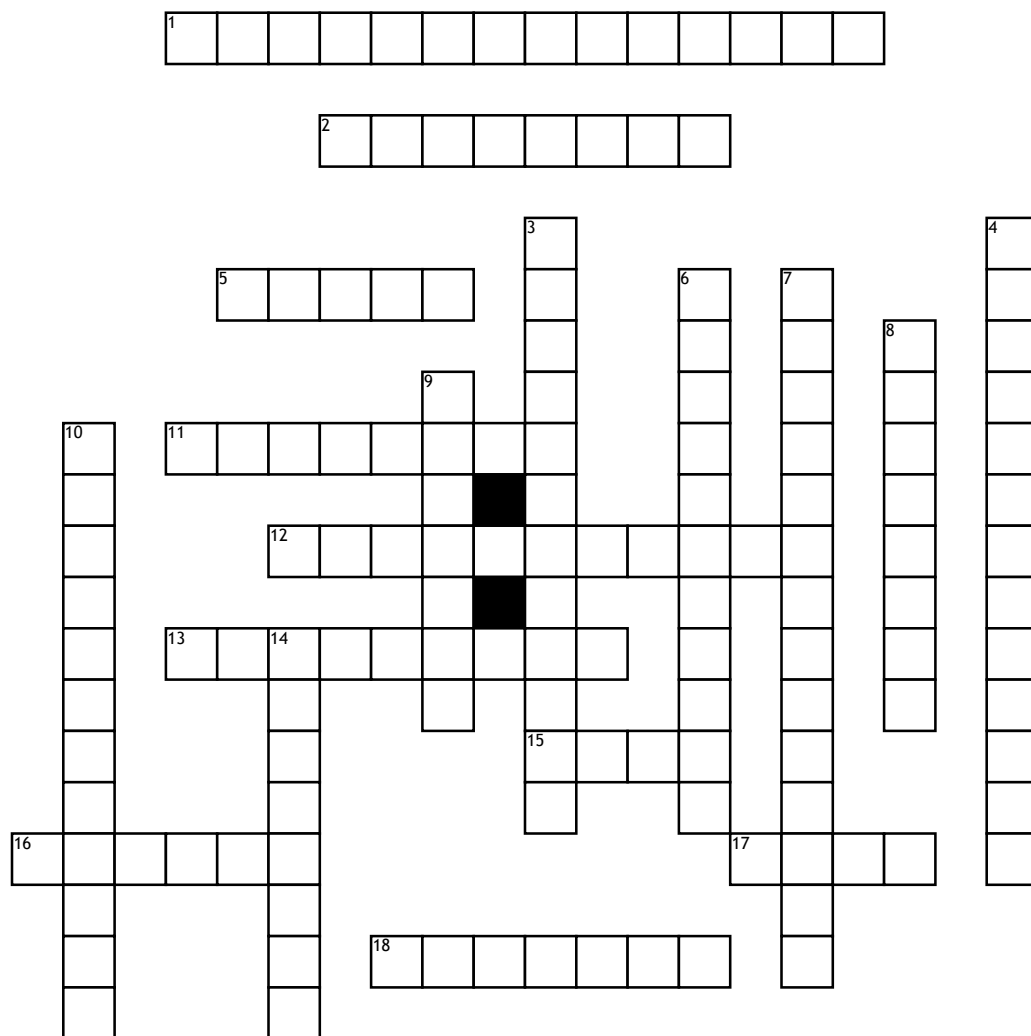


CROSSWORD: SENTENCES
