

- **4.** The place where the trainee traditionally receives instructions for On-The-Job Training.
- **6.** A classroom-based training usually delivered at colleges or educational institutes and on the job training delivered by a fully certified tradesperson.
- **7.** The action which aimed to correct something or to improve that is not performing at required standard.
- **8.** Job Instruction Technique which put employee at ease, built their confidence, enhance their motivation.
- **9.** Usually the person is responsible to deliver the On-The-Job Training.

**10.** Formalized, structured, and systematic approach of training that consists of four steps: preparation, instruction, performance, and follow-up.

## <u>Down</u>

- 1. A training technique that is expensive to purchase and operate, require special knowledge and equipment most likely happening in real job situation.
- 2. Perform an activity or exercise repeatedly or regularly to improve competence of employees.
- 3. Individual guidance to "train" employees with specific performance problems as well as helps manager or executive to develop specific KSAs
