

3. reflection of light or other waves or particles from a surface

5. Each of the lines in which light (and heat) may seem to stream from the sun or any luminous body, or pass through a small opening

1. a line passing through the center of curvature of a lens or spherical mirror and parallel to the axis of symmetry

2. arranged in or constituting a constant or definite pattern, especially with the same space between individual instances
