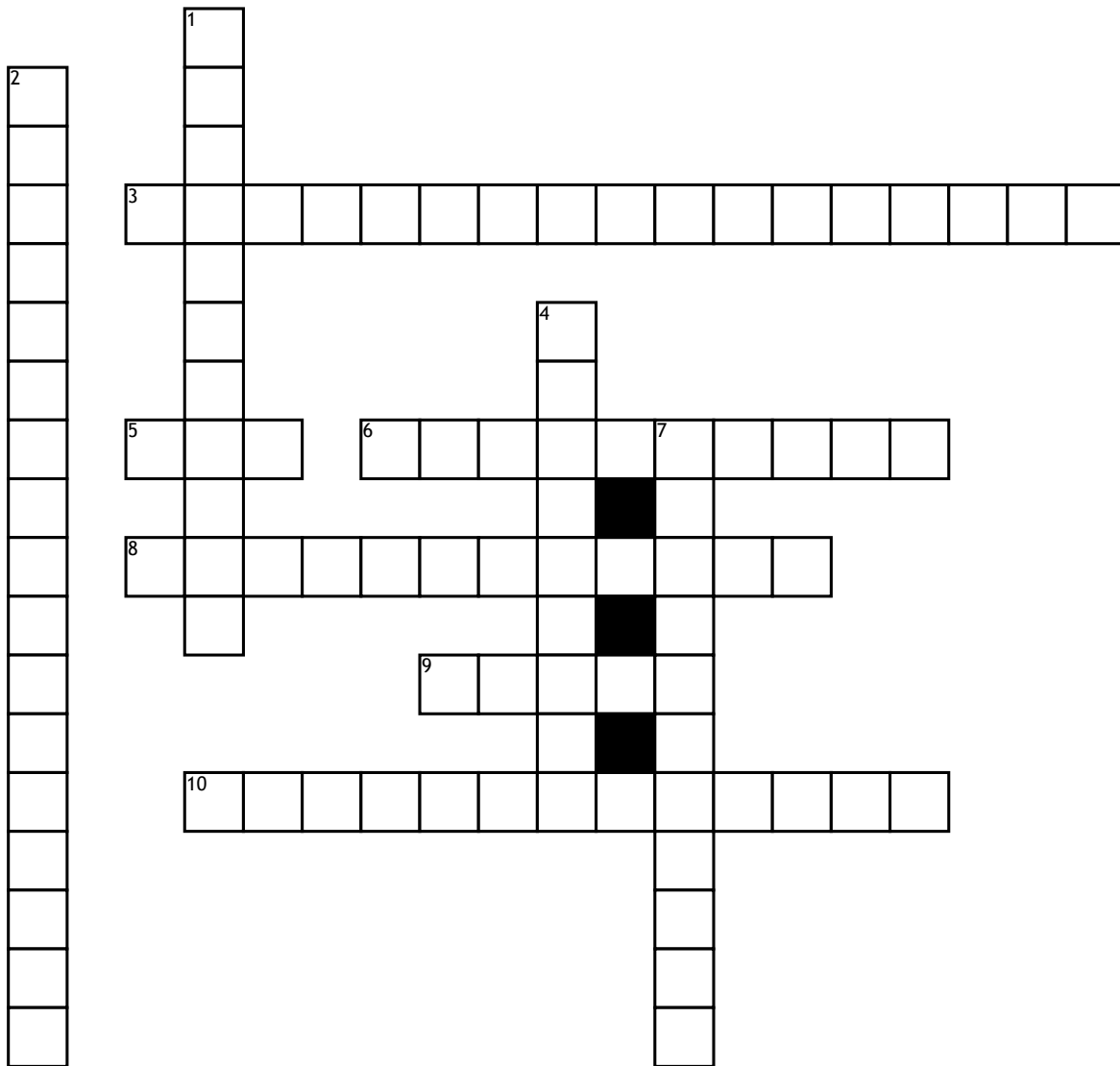


# Can I Believe My Eyes

- 3. reflection of light or other waves or particles from a surface
- 5. Each of the lines in which light (and heat) may seem to stream from the sun or any luminous body, or pass through a small opening
- 6. the point at which rays or waves meet after reflection or refraction, or the point from which diverging rays or waves appear to proceed
- 8. an optical image formed from the apparent divergence of light rays from a point
- 9. a representation of the external form of a person or thing in art

- 10. converging mirror has a reflecting surface that bulges inward

- 1. a line passing through the center of curvature of a lens or spherical mirror and parallel to the axis of symmetry
- 2. arranged in or constituting a constant or definite pattern, especially with the same space between individual instances
- 4. a reproduction of an object via light that can be formed on a surface
