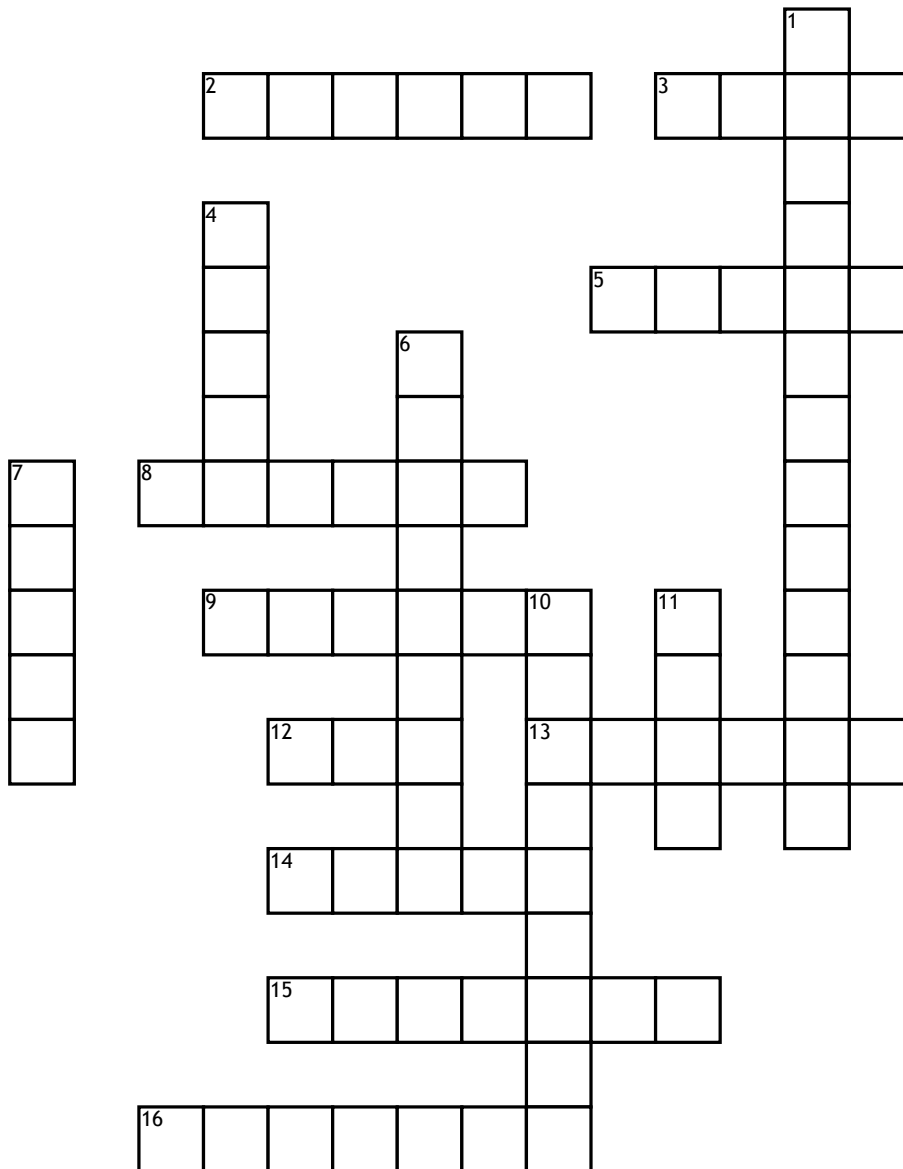


# Canterbury Crossword
