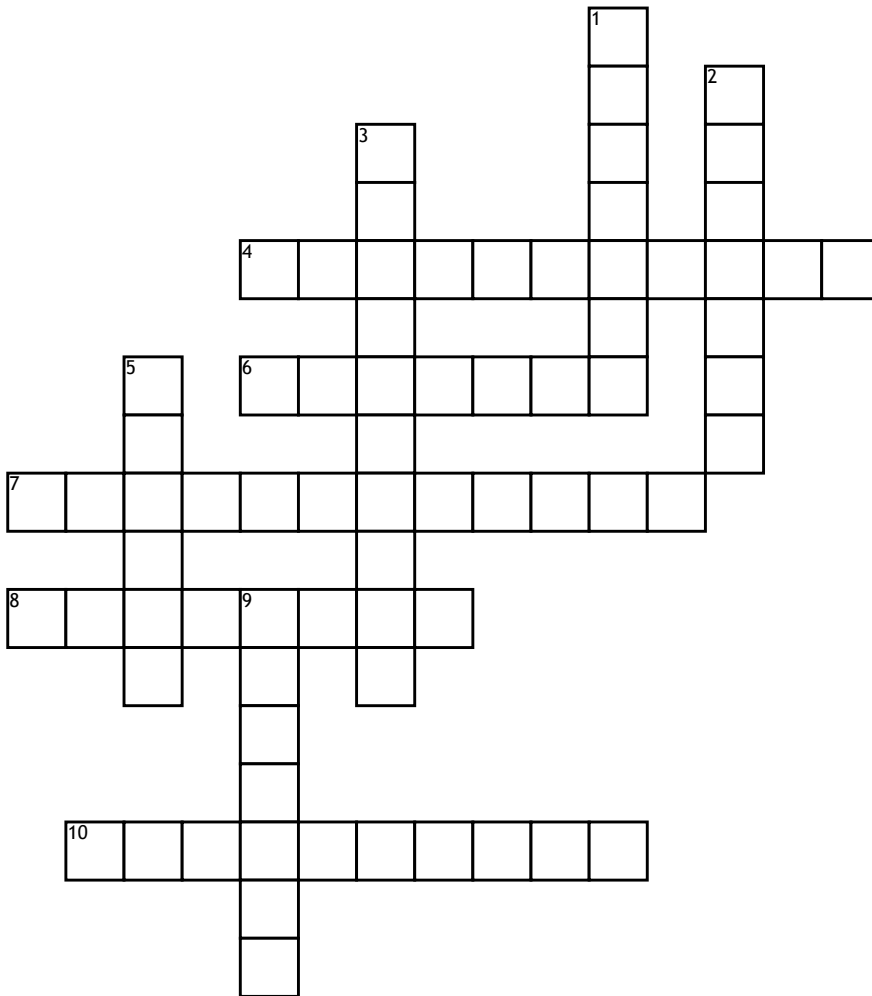


(Cap) Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle
