

## Across

- **5.** The lower chambers on the left and right chambers of the heart.
- **8.** The blunt point at the bottom of the heart.
- **9.** A large vein carrying deoxygenated blood into the heart.
- **10.** A vein carrying oxygenated blood from the lungs to the left atrium of the heart.
- **11.** The muscular wall that divides the left and right sides of the heart.

**12.** Refers to the blood and its role in carrying gases and nutrients around the body.

- 1. A complex transport system that is responsible for supplying oxygen to the tissues of the body and removing waste products.
- 2. The portion of the cardiovascular system that carries oxygen-depleted blood from the heart to the lungs and returns oxygenated blood to the heart.
- **3.** Specialised, voluntary muscle tissue that is found in the heart.
- **4.** The space between two consecutive ribs.
- **6.** A pliable sheet of tissue that surrounds the heart and other organs of the body.
- 7. This is the largest artery in the body. It begins at the top of the left ventricle, the heart's muscular pumping chamber.
