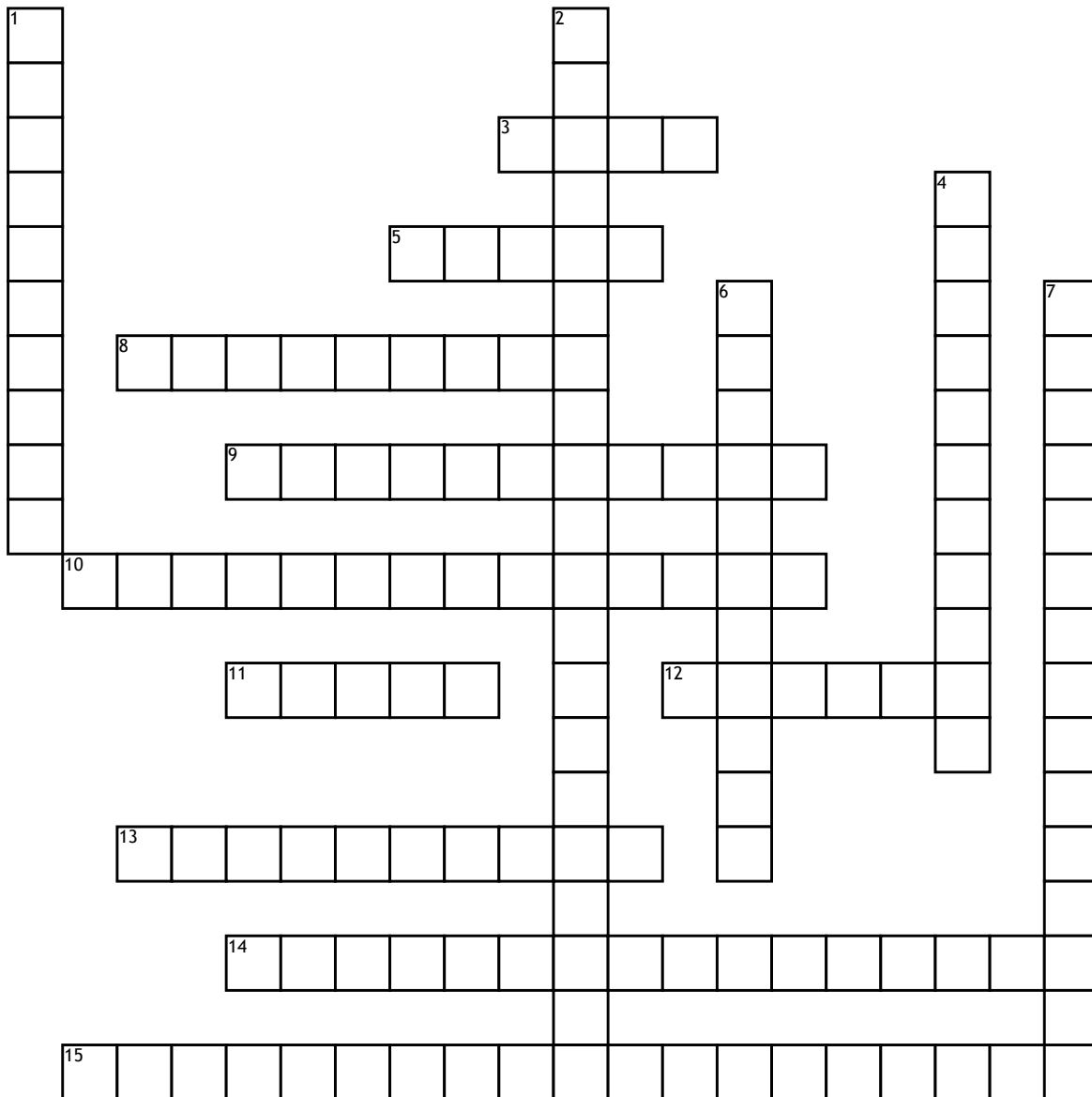

3. A purpose/objective.
 5. Type of interview with multiple interviewers at once
 8. Career Services Location (Suite)
 9. A written statement that is accepted as proof of certain facts; often relating to the attainment of specific skills.
 10. A trainee engages in learning an occupation under the guidance and direction of a skilled worker; a 3-4 year training program on-the- job training with related technical instruction.
 11. Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery - is a test developed and maintained by the United States Department of Defense.

12. One page document sent to employer with job application includes information about education and work experience
 13. A certified, experienced, skilled craftsperson that has successfully completed an apprenticeship program.
 14. Type of college with up to 2-year programs leading to certificates, or associate degrees.
 15. A postsecondary school where a student might receive a bachelor's degree, master's, or doctoral degree in a specific discipline.

1. Allows the student the opportunity to observe and participate in activities related to a career field; related to the student's career choice. (May be paid or unpaid)
