
## **Cath Lab Medications**



## <u>Across</u>

4. Medication used Intra-Coronary for no reflow as well as part of the radial cocktail.
5. Indicated for use in the reduction of mortality associated with acute myocardial infarction (AMI) and utilized if invasive interventions will be prolonged

8. Infusion initiated to help increase BP9. Class III Antiarrhythmic used to pharmacologically cardiovert

**10.** Bolus and/or infusion that is a platelet aggregation inhibitor indicated for treatment of ACS with or without PCI. Also known as Integrillin

11. Multiple uses in the cardiac cath lab such as: Intra-arterial as part of the radial cocktail, IC for no reflow; IV for chest pain and hypertension

## <u>Down</u>

**1.** Loading dose associated with a STEMI and PCI is TYPICALLY 300 mg.

Utilized via infusion catheter as a Lytic gtt
 Used in the EP Lab during an ablation to induce arrhythmias

6. Medication used in FFR to produce a prolonged, steady state of hyperemia with more time to observe the Pd/Pa.

**7.** Used in conjunction with 2 Down to keep vascular sheath open.
