

- **6.** Colored material used to show stories from the bible, found on a cathedral
- $\pmb{8}$. Column or pillar that holds and supports the arch
- 11. Arch which is used to support and strengthen the vault
- 12. Circular or angular end of church (usually pointing to the east)
- 13. Full sized wooden pattern used by stone cutter when he cuts pieces of stone for a cathedral
- 15. Holy relics, and kings or high church officials are buried here
- 17. Between the nave and the clerestory.

- **18.** The part of the church that runs through the middle and around main areas including the nave, choir and transept
- ${\bf 19.}$ Cone or pyramid shaped architecture found on the top of a buttress

- 1. Large stone piers that rise from inside wall and are connected by a flying buttress
- 2. A _____ is a church in the shape of a cross, contains Cathedra or bishop's chair
- **3.** A stone arch which is used to carry the thrust of the vault to the buttress
- **4.** The part of construction that is built on the shape of the arch.

- **5.** Topmost story of church where all windows brighten the central portion of space
- 7. Crosses the nave and the clerestory.
- **9.** Sculptural area enclosed by an arch above the door (may include stained glass or design).
- 10. The central area of the church
- 14. Sits east of the transept, and is sometimes above the level of the nave
- **16.** Decorative stonework of a medieval church window.
