
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Causes of the Revolution

- **2.** acts passed by Parliament in 1767 to tax imports in the colonies
- **5.** series of laws, known in Britain as the Coercive Acts, meant to punish the colonies and clamp down the resistence
- **8.** Americans who sided with the rebels
- 10. incident in 1773, when colonists protested British policies by boarding British ships and throwing their cargoes of tea overboard

- 11. law requiring all legal documents to carry an official stamp showing that a tax had been paid
- **12.** Americans who supported the British
- **13.** law placing a tax on sugar, molasses, and other products shipped to the colonies
- **14.** secret society formed to oppose British policies
