
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## Cell Crossword

- 1. Discovered living cells
- **3.** Contains information for directing a cell's functions
- 9. Produces Protein
- **11.** Surrounds the nucleus and materials pass in and out of the nucleus
- **13.** Objects are viewed through this part on the microscope
- **15.** Adjusts the amount of light passing through the slide and into the objective lense
- **17.** Contains chemicals that break down large food particles into smaller ones
- 18. Where ribosomes are made

- **21.** Barrier that surrounds a cell and controls which substances pass in and out of the cell
- 23. Focuses an image when it is viewed through high-power objective
- 25. Supports the object being viewed

- **2.** Stores water, food, and other materials
- 4. The thick fluid region of the cell
- **5.** Focuses the image when it is viewed through low-power objective
- **6.** A maze of passageways in which proteins and other materials are carried from one part of the cell to another

- 7. Magnifies an image x10
- **8.** Proved that plants have living cells in them
- **10.** Contains the cells genetic material in the form of DNA and controls many of the cells activities
- 12. Magnifies an image x40
- **14.** Separates the lense in the eyepiece from the objective lense below
- **16.** Supports the body above the stage
- 19. Reflects through the stage mirror
- 20. Supports the microscope
- 22. Holds a slide in place on the stage
- **24.** Holds the objective lenses above the stage and rotates so that all lenses may be used
