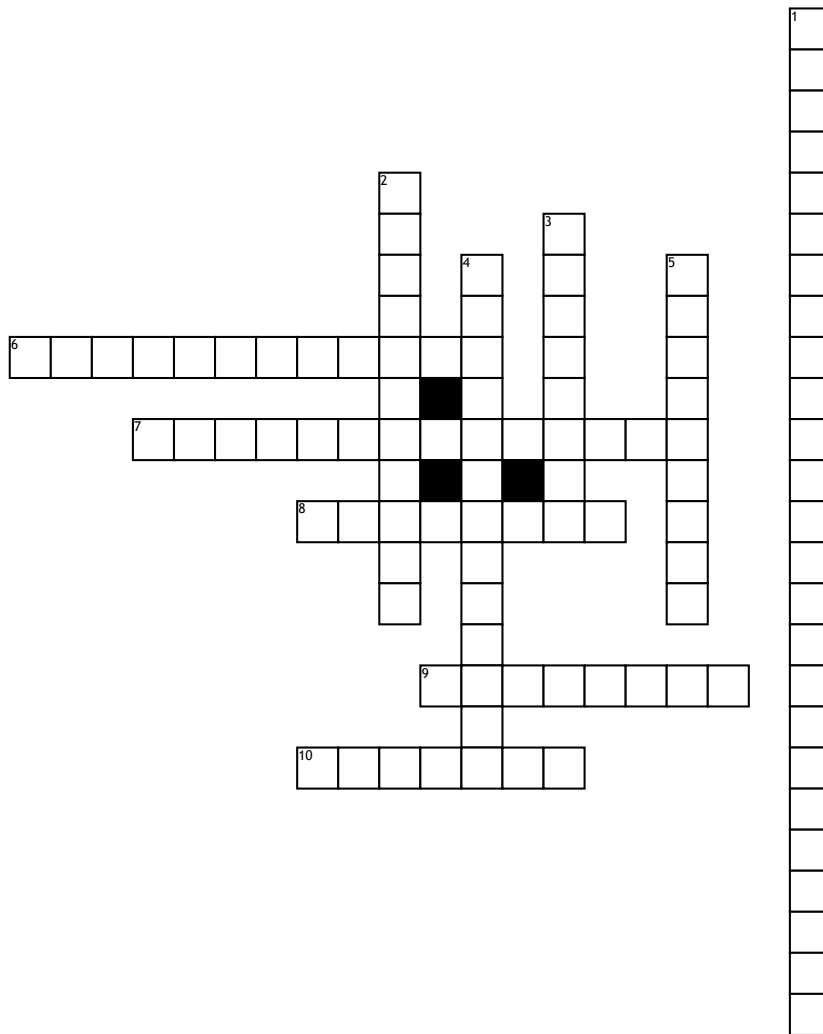

5. tiny organelles that contain RNA and specific proteins within the cytoplasm.
