

- **4.** Very fragile clay that has lost all of its moisture and is ready to fire.
- **9.** A sharp, pointed tool used to sgraffito, cut, decorate and score clay.
- **10.** To empty (carve) out a form.
- **11.** The process of using heat and fusion to convert clay into a glassy substance.

- **12.** Glass-like layer/coating on the surface of pottery.
- **13.** To throw or knead clay firmly on a hard surface to remove air bubbles.

- 1. To scratch or roughen up the surface of two pieces of clay to be joined together.
- 2. Clay that has lost some of its moisture. Too firm to bend (without cracking) but still soft enough to carve.

- **3.** Clay that has not been fired.
- **5.** A fine network of cracks that sometimes occurs on glazes.
- **6.** Clay that is rolled out in a flat sheet before being manipulated.
- **7.** The act of baking clay in the kiln.
- **8.** Curved inward, like a hollow sphere.
