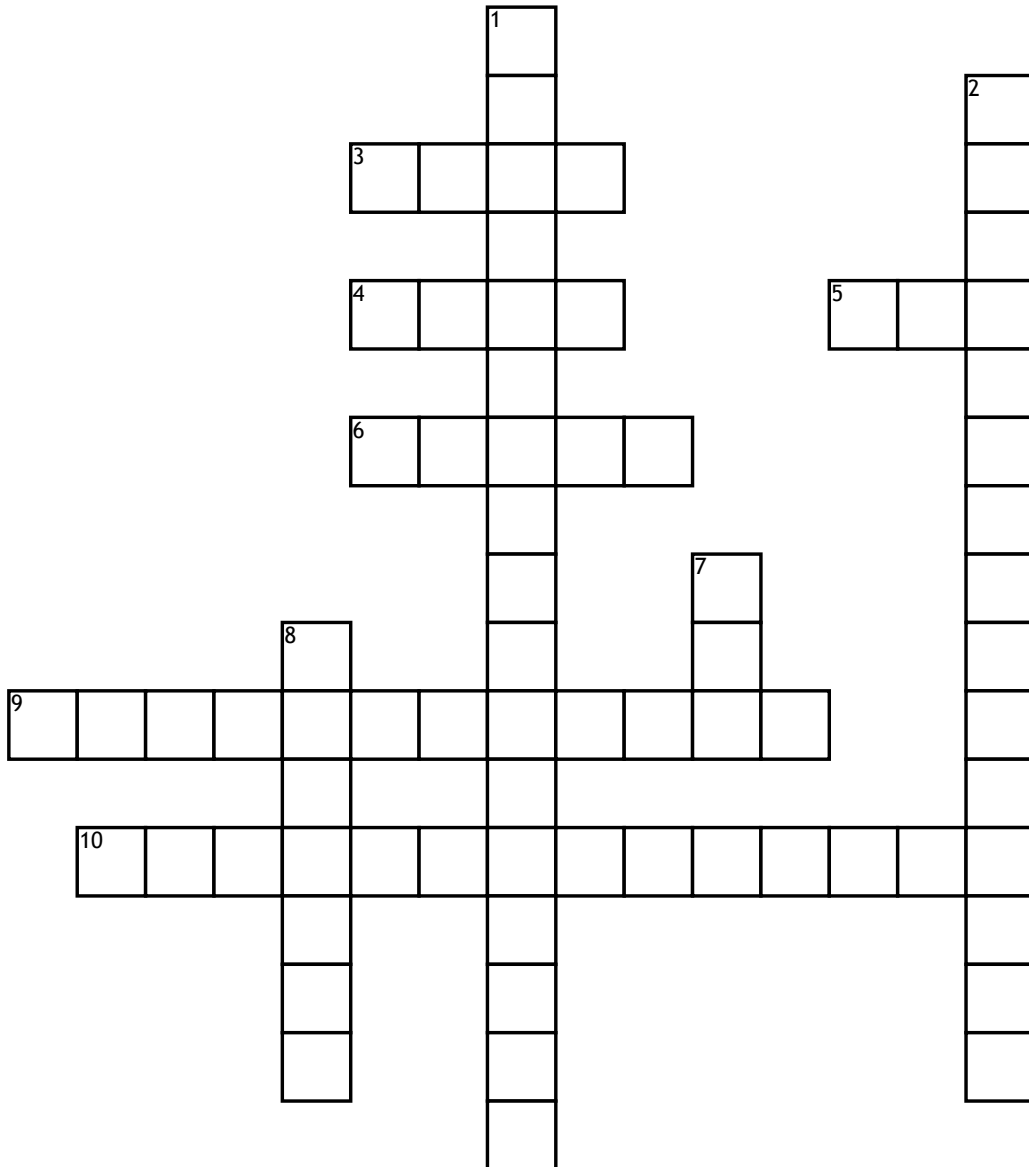

10. Licensed oral healthcare professional who provides preventive, therapeutic, and educational services.
