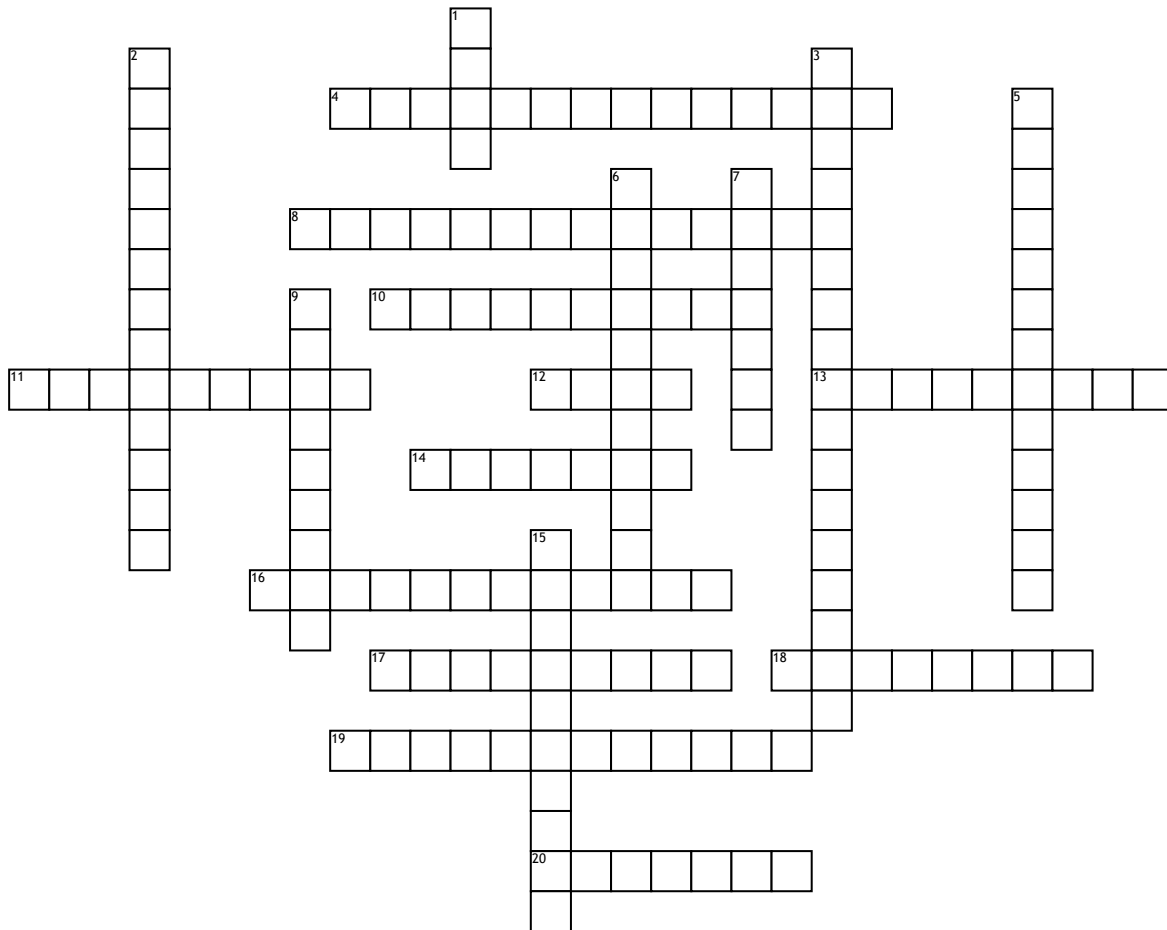


# Ch.8 Crossword Puzzle
