

- **6.** A bar, area, dot, slice, or other symbol in a chart that represents a single data point or value that originates from a datasheet cell
- **10.** A box that identifies the patterns or colors that are assigned to the data series or categories in a chart

- **12.** Related data points that are plotted in a chart and originate from datasheet rows or columns

- 1. A sheet in a workbook that contains only a chart
- **2.** A chart that is placed on a worksheet rather than on a separate chart sheet

- **4.** Descriptive text that is automatically aligned to an axis or centered at the top of a chart
- **5.** In a 2-D chart, the area bounded by the axes, including all data series. In a 3-D chart, the area bounded by the axes, including the data series, category names, tick-mark labels, and axis titles
- **7.** A tiny chart in the background of a cell
- **8.** A label that provides additional information about a data marker
- **9.** Used to record progress or development
