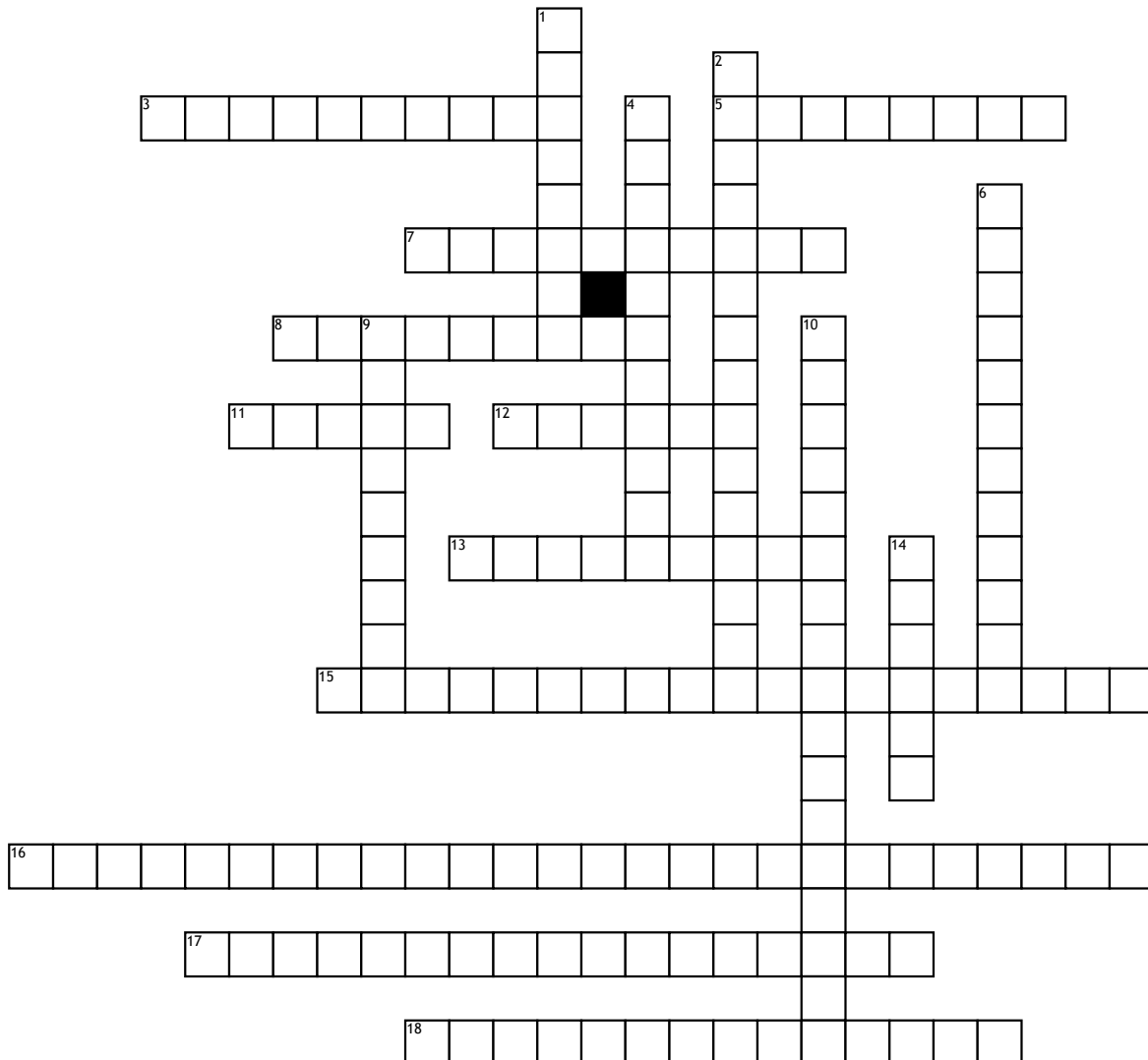


Chapter 10 Crossword Puzzle
