

- 2. A series of congressional measures intended to settle the major disagreements between free and slave states

- 10. Statuses, passed in nine northern states in the 1850s, that forbade the imprisonment of a runaway slaves and guaranteed jury trials for fugitive slaves.
- 14. The idea, expressed by Stephen Douglas in 1858, that any territory could exclude slavery by simply refusing to pass laws supporting it.
- 15. A law, enacted in 1854, that established the territories of Kansas and Nebraska and gave their residents the right to decide whether to allow slavery.

16. A name given to the American party, formed in the 1850s to the curtail the political influence of immigrants

- 1. A law enacted as part of the compromise of 1850, designed to ensure that escaped slaves would be returned into bondage.
- 3. A system in which the residents vote to decide an issue
- 4. The system of routes along which runway slaves were helped to escape to Canada or to safe areas in the free states.
- 5. The confederate states of America, a confederation formed in 1861 by the southern states after their secession from the union

- 7. A best selling novel by Harriet Beecher Stowe, in 1852, that portrayed slavery as a great moral evil.
- 8. Favoring the interests of native-born people over foreign-born people.
- 9. A name applied to the Kansas Territory in the years before the Civil War, when the territory was a battleground between proslavery and antislavery forces.
- 11. An admendment to an 1846 military appropriations bill, proposing that none of the territory acquired in the war with Mexico would be open to slavery.
- 12. A political party formed in 1848 to oppose the extension of slavery into U.S. territories.
- 13. The modern political party that was formed in 1854 by opponents of slavery in the territories
