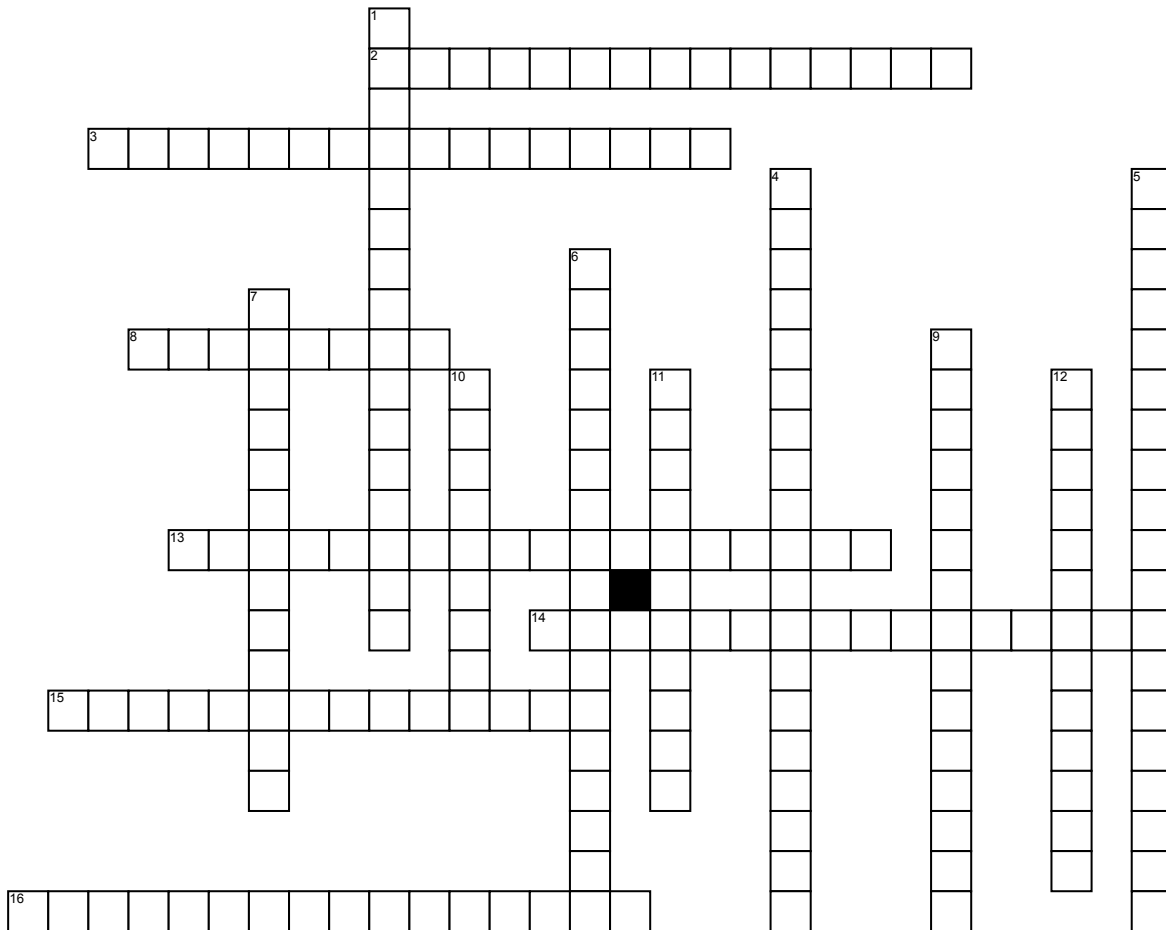

- 6.** The law that established the territories of Kansas and Nebraska and gave residents the right to decide whether to allow slavery
