

- 1. An executive order issued by Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863, freeing the slaves in all regions behind Confederate lines.
- 2. An Amendment to the U.S Constitution, adopted in 1865, that has abolished slavery and involuntary servitude.
- **4.** Legislation passed in 1863 to make banking safer for investors. Its provisions included a system of federally chartered banks, new requirements for loans, and a system for the inspection of banks.

- **5.** Town near Appomattox, Virginia, where Lee surrendered to Grant on April 9, 1865, thus ending the Civil War.
- **6.** A tax on earning.
- 7. An international organization that provides relief to people in times of war or natural disaster. Clara Barton founded the American branch in 1881.
- **8.** A court order requiring authorities to bring a prisoner before the court can determine whether the prisoner is being held legally.
